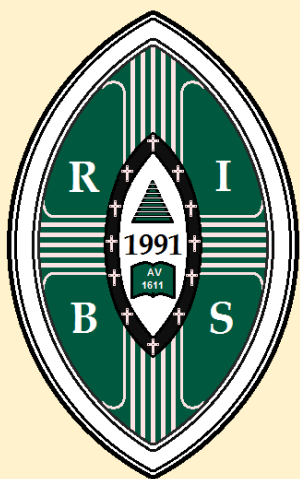

37 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.

38 This is the first and great commandment.

39 And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

40 On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

10 For Moses said, Honour thy father and thy mother; and, Whoso curseth father or mother, let him die the death:

11 But ye say, If a man shall say to his father or mother, It is Corban, that is to say, a gift, by whatsoever thou mightest be profited by me; he shall be free.

13 Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.

Mark 12

29 And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord:

14 Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you.

17 These things I command you, that ye love one another.

Acts 1

2 Until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the Holy Ghost had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen:

4 And, being assembled together with them, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, saith he, ye have heard of me.

Acts 13: 47 For so hath the Lord commanded us, saying, I have set thee to be a light of the Gentiles, that thou shouldest be for salvation unto the ends of the earth.

Romans 13

9 For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet;

Lord Jesus Christ, that ye withdraw yourselves from every brother that walketh disorderly, and not after the tradition which he received of us.

10 For even when we were with you, this we commanded you, that if any would not work, neither should he eat.

12 Now them that are such we command and exhort by our Lord Jesus Christ, that with quietness they work, and eat their own bread.

1 Timothy 1:5 Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart, and of a good conscience, and of faith unfeigned:

Titus 1:3 But hath in due times manifested his word through preaching, which is committed unto me according to the commandment of God our Saviour;

2 Peter 2:21 For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them.

1 John 2

3 And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments.

4 He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

7 Brethren, I write no new commandment unto you, but an old commandment which ye had from the beginning.

The old commandment is the word which ye have heard from the beginning.

8 Again, a new commandment I write unto you, which thing is true in him and in you: because the darkness is past, and the true light now shineth.

1 John 3

22 And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.

23 And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment.

24 And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.

1 John 4:21 And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also.

1 John 5

2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.

3 For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.

2 John 1

4 I rejoiced greatly that I found of thy children walking in truth, as we have received a commandment from the Father.

5 And now I beseech thee, lady, not as though I wrote a new commandment unto thee, but that which we had from

the beginning, that we love one another.

6 And this is love, that we walk after his commandments. This is the commandment, That, as ye have heard from the beginning, ye should walk in it.

Revelation 14:12 Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.

Introduccion

The subject of this class is what every born-again believer should emphasize and make a priority in his life – the commandments of Jesus Christ.

The Old Testament law was a schoolmaster to bring us to Christ. Now, we are no longer under the schoolmaster. We are under Christ and we are obligated to do and teach his doctrine. Jesus' doctrine is made up of his commandments. These are what we call New Testament commandments. It is true we are no longer under the Law of Moses, but we are under the law of Christ. These commandments operate in liberty. This is not liberty to live as one pleases, but liberty to serve one another in love (Galatians 5:13, 14). While some counted 613 Old Testament commandments, we have well over 800 New Testament commandments. The blessing is, as we walk in the Holy Spirit, we fulfill these commandments in the spirit of liberty.

However, it is important that any student of the New Testament familiarize himself with the commandments of Jesus Christ. This is part of the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20)

In Acts 1:1, Luke said he recorded all of what Jesus began to ***Do and Teach***. This is the Doctrine of Christ. His commandments contain all that we are to do and teach (New Testament). His doctrine, although 95% commandments, also hold particular truths that we need to teach. Although these truths are not *direct commandments*, it is inferred that we do and teach them (the beatitudes, parables, etc.). Also, there are particular truths that do not require doing, but we are to teach them (Jesus is the Light of the world, he is the propitiation for our sins, he is coming again, etc.) These truths do provoke action on the part of the believer. All these things make up the doctrine of Christ.

This paper is a help and a guide to the Bachelor level students so that they can accomplish the assigned objective. The student may easily use the information here to create his own list, or divide, apply, or describe the commandments in a different way.

However this information is used, the student should read every verse and know that he understands the commandment. He should also purpose in his heart to do and teach them to the best of his ability – by example. This is his doctrine and he should be well-versed in it.

Because there are four Gospels and they see things similarly, there will be overlap or repetition of certain commandments. We still listed these as separate items, rather than try to combine them. This method allows a cleaner base for future work, and also provides repetition – there is reason for it. Repetition is the mother of all learning. The last lesson (Lesson 7) shows a topical dividing up of the commandments and cross-references the similar verses.

The objective for the Class 406 is for the student to study and learn the commandments, and then use them and present them in a profitable way. A simple list is easy to do. How to arrange the commandments (rightly divide) are numerous. The student should pray about how to make a study of the commandments. Here are some ideas:

- Show personal commandments (not in relation to others)
- Show interpersonal commandments
- Show those commandments related to sanctification
- Show those commandments related to second coming

- Make translations, or compare translations

Some may argue the applicability to us of some of the commandments. There is merit in rightly dividing to whom Jesus is speaking (i.e., John 13:27). This, too, would be a good study. However, much caution should be taken when studying this way as we must not simply pick and choose the commandments we like. All in all, Jesus never wasted words. If he provided his words to us, we should know the application and how it applies to those not directly addressed.

Keep in mind this class is not really a class, but a self-directed writing objective. We have shown we have done our part. *We do not ask of students that which we have not done ourselves.* This syllabus is evidence of the work done to record our Lord's commandments.

We need also to understand the words of the apostles are also considered equally the commandments of the Lord Jesus Christ (1 Corinthians 14:37). This, too, would be a great study, one which the scope of these notes provides generally, but not in a separate fashion. The apostles were faithful to teach "all things" that Christ commanded. We should not overlook these commandments.

This first part of this study covers only the four gospels, Acts, and the Revelation. Lesson 7 includes apostolic revelation on the subject.

The Commandments of Christ and their connection to Love Commandment Doctrine

As with every class, we must understand the subject and its connection to the Great Commandment of Loving God and your brother.

Jesus said (John 14:15), If you love me, keep my commandments. Furthermore, he sent his preachers into the world to teach all things that he commanded (Matthew 28:20). A preacher that is faithful to Christ will know, love, do, and teach what Jesus Commanded. If you love me, keep my commandments (John 14:15).

Leccion 1: Mateo

- 1 3:15 And Jesus answering said unto him, Suffer it to be so now: for thus it becometh us to fulfil all righteousness. Then he suffered him.
- 2 4:4 But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.
- 3 7 Jesus said unto him, It is written again, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God.
- 4 10 Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.

- 41 5 And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites are: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.
- 42 6 But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly.
- 43 7 But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen do: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking.
- 44 8 Be not ye therefore like unto them: for your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask him.
- 45 9 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

- 49 20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:
- 50, 51, 52, 53 25 Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment?

- 61, 62, 63 7 Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:
- 64 12 Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets.
- 65 13 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat:
- 66 15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- 67 8:3 And Jesus put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.
- 68, 69, 70, 71 4 And Jesus saith unto him, See thou tell no man; but go thy way, shew thyself to the priest, and offer the gift that Moses commanded, for a testimony unto them.
- 72 13 And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour.
- 73, 74 22 But Jesus said unto him, Follow me; and let the dead bury their dead.
- 75 9:9 And as Jesus passed forth from thence, he saw a man, named Matthew, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he saith unto him, Follow me. And he arose, and followed him.

- 76 13 But go ye and learn what that meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.
- 77 22 But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour.
- 78 24 He said unto them, Give place: for the maid is not dead, but sleepeth. And they laughed him to scorn.
- 79 30 And their eyes were opened; and Jesus straitly charged them, saying, See that no man know it.
- 80 38 Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest.
- 81 10:5 These twelve Jesus sent forth, and commanded them, saying, Go not into the way of the Gentiles, and into any city of the Samaritans enter ye not:
- 82 6 But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.
- 83 7 And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- 84, 85, 86, 87 8 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.
- 88, 89, 90 9 Provide neither gold, nor silver, nor brass in your purses,
- 91, 92, 93, 94 10 Nor scrip for your journey, neither two coats, neither shoes, nor yet staves: for the workman is worthy of his meat.
- 95, 96 11 And into whatsoever city or town ye shall enter, inquire who in it is worthy; and there abide till ye go thence.
- 97 12 And when ye come into an house, salute it.
- 98, 99 13 And if the house be worthy, let your peace come upon it: but if it be not worthy, let your peace return to you.
- 100 14 And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear your words, when ye depart out of that house or city, shake off the dust of your feet.
- 101, 102 16 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.
- 103 17 But beware of men: for they will deliver you up to the councils, and they will scourge you in their synagogues;
- 104 19 But when they deliver you up, take no thought how or what ye shall speak: for it shall be given you in that same hour what ye shall speak.
- 105 23 But when they persecute you in this city, flee ye into another: for verily I say unto you, Ye shall not have gone over the cities of Israel, till the Son of man be come.
- 106 26 Fear them not therefore: for there is nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; and hid, that shall not be known.

- 107, 108 27 What I tell you in darkness, that speak ye in light: and what ye hear in the ear, that preach ye upon the housetops.
- 109, 110 28 And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.
- 111 31 Fear ye not therefore, ye are of more value than many sparrows.
- 112 34 Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword.
- 113, 114 11:4 Jesus answered and said unto them, Go and shew John again those things which ye do hear and see:
- 115 6 And blessed is he, whosoever shall not be offended in me.
- 116 15 He that hath ears to hear, let him hear.
- 117 28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- 118, 119 29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.
- 120 12:13 Then saith he to the man, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched it forth; and it was restored whole, like as the other.
- 121 13:16 But blessed are your eyes, for they see: and your ears, for they hear.
- 122 18 Hear ye therefore the parable of the sower.
- 123 29 But he said, Nay; lest while ye gather up the tares, ye root up also the wheat with them.
- 124, 125,
126, 12730 Let both grow together until the harvest: and in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: but gather the wheat into my barn.
- 128 14:16 But Jesus said unto them, They need not depart; give ye them to eat.
- 129 18 He said, Bring them hither to me.
- 130 19 And he commanded the multitude to sit down on the grass, and took the five loaves, and the two fishes, and looking up to heaven, he blessed, and brake, and gave the loaves to his disciples, and the disciples to the multitude.
- 131 27 But straightway Jesus spake unto them, saying, Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid.
- 132 29 And he said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus.
- 133, 134 15:10 And he called the multitude, and said unto them, Hear, and understand:
- 135 14 Let them alone: they be blind leaders of the blind. And if the blind lead the blind, both shall fall into the ditch.

- 136 28 Then Jesus answered and said unto her, O woman, great is thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt. And her daughter was made whole from that very hour.

- 139 23 But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men.

- 143, 144 17:7 And Jesus came and touched them, and said, Arise, and be not afraid.
- 145 9 And as they came down from the mountain, Jesus charged them, saying, Tell the vision to no man, until the Son of man be risen again from the dead.
- 146 17 Then Jesus answered and said, O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer you? bring him hither to me.
- 147, 148, 149, 150, 151 27 Notwithstanding, lest we should offend them, go thou to the sea, and cast an hook, and take up the fish that first cometh up; and when thou hast opened his mouth, thou shalt find a piece of money: that take, and give unto them for me and thee.
- 152, 153 18:8 Wherefore if thy hand or thy foot offend thee, cut them off, and cast them from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life halt or maimed, rather than having two hands or two feet to be cast into everlasting fire.
- 154, 155 9 And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast it from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life with one eye, rather than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire.
- 156 10 Take heed that ye despise not one of these little ones; for I say unto you, That in heaven their angels do always behold the face of my Father which is in heaven.
- 157 15 Moreover if thy brother shall trespass against thee, go and tell him his fault between thee and him alone: if he shall hear thee, thou hast gained thy brother.
- 158 16 But if he will not hear thee, then take with thee one or two more, that in the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established.
- 159, 160 17 And if he shall neglect to hear them, tell it unto the church: but if he neglect to hear the church, let him be unto thee as an heathen man and a publican.
- 161 22 Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven.
- 162 19:6 Wherefore they are no more twain, but one flesh. What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder.
- 163 12 For there are some eunuchs, which were so born from their mother's womb: and there are some eunuchs, which were made eunuchs of men: and there be eunuchs, which have made themselves eunuchs for the kingdom of heaven's sake. He that is able to receive it, let him receive it.

- 164, 165 14 But Jesus said, Suffer little children, and forbid them not, to come unto me: for of such is the kingdom of heaven.

- 177 7 They say unto him, Because no man hath hired us. He saith unto them, Go ye also into the vineyard; and whatsoever is right, that shall ye receive.
- 178, 179, 180 8 So when even was come, the lord of the vineyard saith unto his steward, Call the labourers, and give them their hire, beginning from the last unto the first.
- 181, 182 14 Take that thine is, and go thy way: I will give unto this last, even as unto thee.
- 183 26 But it shall not be so among you: but whosoever will be great among you, let him be your minister;
- 184 27 And whosoever will be chief among you, let him be your servant:
- 185, 186 21:2 Saying unto them, Go into the village over against you, and straightway ye shall find an ass tied, and a colt with her: loose them, and bring them unto me.
- 187 3 And if any man say ought unto you, ye shall say, The Lord hath need of them; and straightway he will send them.
- 188 13 And said unto them, It is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- 189 19 And when he saw a fig tree in the way, he came to it, and found nothing thereon, but leaves only, and said unto it, Let no fruit grow on thee henceforward for ever. And presently the fig tree withered away.
- 190 22 And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.
- 191 22:4 Again, he sent forth other servants, saying, Tell them which are bidden, Behold, I have prepared my dinner: my oxen and my fatlings are killed, and all things are ready: come unto the marriage.
- 192 9 Go ye therefore into the highways, and as many as ye shall find, bid to the marriage.
- 193, 194, 195 13 Then said the king to the servants, Bind him hand and foot, and take him away, and cast him into outer darkness; there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

- 196 19 Shew me the tribute money. And they brought unto him a penny.

- 204 10 Neither be ye called masters: for one is your Master, even Christ.
- 205 11 But he that is greatest among you shall be your servant.
- 206, 207 12 And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall humble himself shall be exalted.
- 208, 209 23 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier matters of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.
- 210 26 Thou blind Pharisee, cleanse first that which is within the cup and platter, that the outside of them may be clean also.
- 211 32 Fill ye up then the measure of your fathers.
- 212 24:4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.
- 213 15 When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)
- 214 16 Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains:
- 215 17 Let him which is on the housetop not come down to take any thing out of his house:
- 216 18 Neither let him which is in the field return back to take his clothes.
- 217, 218 20 But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the sabbath day:
- 219 23 Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here is Christ, or there; believe it not.
- 220 32 Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is nigh:
- 221 33 So likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, even at the doors.
- 222 42 Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come.

- 223 44 Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh.
- 224 46 Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing.

- 226 21 His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.
- 227 23 His lord said unto him, Well done, good and faithful servant; thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.
- 228 27 Thou oughtest therefore to have put my money to the exchangers, and then at my coming I should have received mine own with usury.
- 229, 230 28 Take therefore the talent from him, and give it unto him which hath ten talents.
- 231 30 And cast ye the unprofitable servant into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.
- 232, 233 34 Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:
- 234 1 Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:
- 235 26:13 Verily I say unto you, Wheresoever this gospel shall be preached in the whole world, there shall also this, that this woman hath done, be told for a memorial of her.
- 236, 237 18 And he said, Go into the city to such a man, and say unto him, The Master saith, My time is at hand; I will keep the passover at thy house with my disciples.
- 238 26 And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed it, and brake it, and gave it to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body.
- 239 27 And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, Drink ye all of it;
- 240, 241 38 Then saith he unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful, even unto death: tarry ye here, and watch with me.
- 242, 243 41 Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.
- 244, 245 45 Then cometh he to his disciples, and saith unto them, Sleep on now, and take your rest: behold, the hour is at hand, and the Son of man is betrayed into the hands of sinners.
- 246, 247 46 Rise, let us be going: behold, he is at hand that doth betray me.
- 248 52 Then said Jesus unto him, Put up again thy sword into his place: for all they that take the sword shall perish with the sword.
- 249, 250 28:10 Then said Jesus unto them, Be not afraid: go tell my brethren that they go into Galilee, and there shall they see me.

- 266, 267, 268 2:11 I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy bed, and go thy way into thine house.
- 269 14 And as he passed by, he saw Levi the son of Alphaeus sitting at the receipt of custom, and said unto him, Follow me. And he arose and followed him.
- 270 3:3 And he saith unto the man which had the withered hand, Stand forth.
- 271 5 And when he had looked round about on them with anger, being grieved for the hardness of their hearts, he saith unto the man, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched it out: and his hand was restored whole as the other.
- 272 12 And he straitly charged them that they should not make him known.
- 273 13 And he goeth up into a mountain, and calleth unto him whom he would: and they came unto him.
- 274, 275 14 And he ordained twelve, that they should be with him, and that he might send them forth to preach,
- 276, 277 15 And to have power to heal sicknesses, and to cast out devils:
- 278 4:23 If any man have ears to hear, let him hear.
- 279 24 And he said unto them, Take heed what ye hear: with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you: and unto you that hear shall more be given.
- 280 35 And the same day, when the even was come, he saith unto them, Let us pass over unto the other side.
- 281 39 And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm.
- 282 5:8 For he said unto him, Come out of the man, thou unclean spirit.

- 283, 284 19 Howbeit Jesus suffered him not, but saith unto him, Go home to thy friends, and tell them how great things the Lord hath done for thee, and hath had compassion on thee.

- 293 10 And he said unto them, In what place soever ye enter into an house, there abide till ye depart from that place.
- 294 11 And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear you, when ye depart thence, shake off the dust under your feet for a testimony against them. Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrhah in the day of judgment, than for that city.
- 295, 296 31 And he said unto them, Come ye yourselves apart into a desert place, and rest a while: for there were many coming and going, and they had no leisure so much as to eat.
- 297 37 He answered and said unto them, Give ye them to eat. And they say unto him, Shall we go and buy two hundred pennyworth of bread, and give them to eat?
- 298 39 And he commanded them to make all sit down by companies upon the green grass.
- 299 45 And straightway he constrained his disciples to get into the ship, and to go to the other side before unto Bethsaida, while he sent away the people.
- 300, 301 50 For they all saw him, and were troubled. And immediately he talked with them, and saith unto them, Be of good cheer: it is I; be not afraid.
- 302 7:16 If any man have ears to hear, let him hear.
- 303 27 But Jesus said unto her, Let the children first be filled: for it is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast it unto the dogs.
- 304 29 And he said unto her, For this saying go thy way; the devil is gone out of thy daughter.
- 305 36 And he charged them that they should tell no man: but the more he charged them, so much the more a great deal they published it;
- 306 8:6 And he commanded the people to sit down on the ground: and he took the seven loaves, and gave thanks, and brake, and gave to his disciples to set before them; and they did set them before the people.

- 307 26 And he sent him away to his house, saying, Neither go into the town, nor tell it to any in the town.
- 308 30 And he charged them that they should tell no man of him.
- 309 33 But when he had turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked Peter, saying, Get thee behind me, Satan: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but the things that be of men.
- 310 34 And when he had called the people unto him with his disciples also, he said unto them, Whosoever will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.
- 311 35 For whosoever will save his life shall lose it; but whosoever shall lose his life for my sake and the gospel's, the same shall save it.
- 312 9:19 He answereth him, and saith, O faithless generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer you? bring him unto me.
- 313 25 When Jesus saw that the people came running together, he rebuked the foul spirit, saying unto him, Thou dumb and deaf spirit, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him.
- 314 29 And he said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.
- 315 35 And he sat down, and called the twelve, and saith unto them, If any man desire to be first, the same shall be last of all, and servant of all.
- 316 37 Whosoever shall receive one of such children in my name, receiveth me: and whosoever shall receive me, receiveth not me, but him that sent me.
- 317 39 But Jesus said, Forbid him not: for there is no man which shall do a miracle in my name, that can lightly speak evil of me.
- 318 41 For whosoever shall give you a cup of water to drink in my name, because ye belong to Christ, verily I say unto you, he shall not lose his reward.
- 319 42 And whosoever shall offend one of these little ones that believe in me, it is better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he were cast into the sea.
- 320 43 And if thy hand offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter into life maimed, than having two hands to go into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched:
- 321 45 And if thy foot offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter halt into life, than having two feet to be cast into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched:
- 322 47 And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out: it is better for thee to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye, than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire:
- 323 49 For every one shall be salted with fire, and every sacrifice shall be salted with salt.
- 324 10:9 What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder.
- 325 25 It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God.

- 325 31 But many that are first shall be last; and the last first.
- 326 29 And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, and the gospel's,
- 326 43 But so shall it not be among you: but whosoever will be great among you, shall be your minister:
- 327 30 But he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life.
- 327 44 And whosoever of you will be the chiefest, shall be servant of all.
- 328 49 And Jesus stood still, and commanded him to be called. And they call the blind man, saying unto him, Be of good comfort, rise; he calleth thee.
- 329, 330, 331 11:2 And saith unto them, Go your way into the village over against you: and as soon as ye be entered into it, ye shall find a colt tied, whereon never man sat; loose him, and bring him.
- 332 3 And if any man say unto you, Why do ye this? say ye that the Lord hath need of him; and straightway he will send him hither.
- 333 14 And Jesus answered and said unto it, No man eat fruit of thee hereafter for ever. And his disciples heard it.
- 334 17 And he taught, saying unto them, Is it not written, My house shall be called of all nations the house of prayer? but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- 335 22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.
- 336 23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.
- 337 24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.
- 338 25 And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.
- 339 26 But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.
- 340 12:25 For when they shall rise from the dead, they neither marry, nor are given in marriage; but are as the angels which are in heaven.
- 341 29 And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord:
- 342 30 And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment.
- 343 31 And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.

- 351 15 And let him that is on the housetop not go down into the house, neither enter therein, to take any thing out of his house:
- 352 16 And let him that is in the field not turn back again for to take up his garment.
- 353 18 And pray ye that your flight be not in the winter.
- 354 21 And then if any man shall say to you, Lo, here is Christ; or, lo, he is there; believe him not:
- 355 23 But take ye heed: behold, I have foretold you all things.
- 356 28 Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When her branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is near:
- 357 29 So ye in like manner, when ye shall see these things come to pass, know that it is nigh, even at the doors.
- 358, 359, 360 33 Take ye heed, watch and pray: for ye know not when the time is.
- 361 35 Watch ye therefore: for ye know not when the master of the house cometh, at even, or at midnight, or at the cockcrowing, or in the morning:
- 362 37 And what I say unto you I say unto all, Watch.
- 363 14:6 And Jesus said, Let her alone; why trouble ye her? she hath wrought a good work on me.
- 364 9 Verily I say unto you, Wheresoever this gospel shall be preached throughout the whole world, this also that she hath done shall be spoken of for a memorial of her.
- 365, 366 13 And he sendeth forth two of his disciples, and saith unto them, Go ye into the city, and there shall meet you a man bearing a pitcher of water: follow him.

CLASS 406 LOS MANDAMIENTOS DE JESUCRISTO

- 367, 368 14 And wheresoever he shall go in, say ye to the goodman of the house, The Master saith, Where is the guestchamber, where I shall eat the passover with my disciples?
- 369 15 And he will shew you a large upper room furnished and prepared: there make ready for us.
- 370 22 And as they did eat, Jesus took bread, and blessed, and brake it, and gave to them, and said, Take, eat: this is my body.
- 371 32 And they came to a place which was named Gethsemane: and he saith to his disciples, Sit ye here, while I shall pray.
- 372, 373 34 And saith unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful unto death: tarry ye here, and watch.
- 374, 375 38 Watch ye and pray, lest ye enter into temptation. The spirit truly is ready, but the flesh is weak.
- 376, 377 41 And he cometh the third time, and saith unto them, Sleep on now, and take your rest: it is enough, the hour is come; behold, the Son of man is betrayed into the hands of sinners.
- 378 42 Rise up, let us go; lo, he that betrayeth me is at hand.
- 379, 380 16:15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.
- 381, 382 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.
- 383, 384 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- 385, 386, 387 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

- 388 2:49 And he said unto them, How is it that ye sought me? wist ye not that I must be about my Father's business?
- 389 4:4 And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.
- 390, 391, 392 8 And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.
- 393 12 And Jesus answering said unto him, It is said, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God.
- 394, 395 35 And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him. And when the devil had thrown him in the midst, he came out of him, and hurt him not.
- 396, 397 5:4 Now when he had left speaking, he said unto Simon, Launch out into the deep, and let down your nets for a draught.
- 398, 399 10 And so was also James, and John, the sons of Zebedee, which were partners with Simon. And Jesus said unto Simon, Fear not; from henceforth thou shalt catch men.
- 400 20 And when he saw their faith, he said unto him, Man, thy sins are forgiven thee.
- 401, 402, 403 24 But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power upon earth to forgive sins, (he said unto the sick of the palsy,) I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy couch, and go into thine house.
- 404 27 And after these things he went forth, and saw a publican, named Levi, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he said unto him, Follow me.
- 405 31 And Jesus answering said unto them, They that are whole need not a physician; but they that are sick.
- 406 32 I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.
- 407 6:5 And he said unto them, That the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath.
- 408, 409 8 But he knew their thoughts, and said to the man which had the withered hand, Rise up, and stand forth in the midst. And he arose and stood forth.
- 410 10 And looking round about upon them all, he said unto the man, Stretch forth thy hand. And he did so: and his hand was restored whole as the other.
- 411 20 And he lifted up his eyes on his disciples, and said, Blessed be ye poor: for yours is the kingdom of God.
- 412, 413 21 Blessed are ye that hunger now: for ye shall be filled. Blessed are ye that weep now: for ye shall laugh.
- 414, 415, 416, 417 22 Blessed are ye, when men shall hate you, and when they shall separate you from their company, and shall reproach you, and cast out your name as evil, for the Son of man's sake.

CLASS 406 LOS MANDAMIENTOS DE JESUCRISTO

- 418 23 Rejoice ye in that day, and leap for joy: for, behold, your reward is great in heaven: for in the like manner did their fathers unto the prophets.
- 419 24 But woe unto you that are rich! for ye have received your consolation.
- 420 25 Woe unto you that are full! for ye shall hunger. Woe unto you that laugh now! for ye shall mourn and weep.
- 421 26 Woe unto you, when all men shall speak well of you! for so did their fathers to the false prophets.
- 422, 423 27 But I say unto you which hear, Love your enemies, do good to them which hate you,
- 424, 425 28 Bless them that curse you, and pray for them which despitefully use you.
- 426, 427 29 And unto him that smiteth thee on the one cheek offer also the other; and him that taketh away thy cloke forbid not to take thy coat also.
- 428, 429 30 Give to every man that asketh of thee; and of him that taketh away thy goods ask them not again.
- 430 31 And as ye would that men should do to you, do ye also to them likewise.
- 431, 432, 433 35 But love ye your enemies, and do good, and lend, hoping for nothing again; and your reward shall be great, and ye shall be the children of the Highest: for he is kind unto the unthankful and to the evil.
- 434 36 Be ye therefore merciful, as your Father also is merciful.
- 435, 436, 437 37 Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned: forgive, and ye shall be forgiven:
- 438, 439 38 Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.
- 440 40 The disciple is not above his master: but every one that is perfect shall be as his master.
- 441, 442 42 Either how canst thou say to thy brother, Brother, let me pull out the mote that is in thine eye, when thou thyself beholdest not the beam that is in thine own eye? Thou hypocrite, cast out first the beam out of thine own eye, and then shalt thou see clearly to pull out the mote that is in thy brother's eye.
- 443 43 For a good tree bringeth not forth corrupt fruit; neither doth a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit.
- 444 44 For every tree is known by his own fruit. For of thorns men do not gather figs, nor of a bramble bush gather they grapes.
- 445 45 A good man out of the good treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is evil: for of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaketh.
- 446 46 And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?

CLASS 406 LOS MANDAMIENTOS DE JESUCRISTO

- 447 48 He is like a man which built an house, and digged deep, and laid the foundation on a rock: and when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently upon that house, and could not shake it: for it was founded upon a rock.
- 448 49 But he that heareth, and doeth not, is like a man that without a foundation built an house upon the earth; against which the stream did beat vehemently, and immediately it fell; and the ruin of that house was great.
- 449 7:13 And when the Lord saw her, he had compassion on her, and said unto her, Weep not.
- 450 14 And he came and touched the bier: and they that bare him stood still. And he said, Young man, I say unto thee, Arise.
- 451, 452 22 Then Jesus answering said unto them, Go your way, and tell John what things ye have seen and heard; how that the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, to the poor the gospel is preached.
- 453 23 And blessed is he, whosoever shall not be offended in me.
- 454 28 For I say unto you, Among those that are born of women there is not a greater prophet than John the Baptist: but he that is least in the kingdom of God is greater than he.
- 455 50 And he said to the woman, Thy faith hath saved thee; go in peace.
- 456 8:10 And he said, Unto you it is given to know the mysteries of the kingdom of God: but to others in parables; that seeing they might not see, and hearing they might not understand.
- 457 17 For nothing is secret, that shall not be made manifest; neither any thing hid, that shall not be known and come abroad.
- 458 18 Take heed therefore how ye hear: for whosoever hath, to him shall be given; and whosoever hath not, from him shall be taken even that which he seemeth to have.
- 459 21 And he answered and said unto them, My mother and my brethren are these which hear the word of God, and do it.
- 460 22 Now it came to pass on a certain day, that he went into a ship with his disciples: and he said unto them, Let us go over unto the other side of the lake. And they launched forth.
- 461 29 (For he had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For oftentimes it had caught him: and he was kept bound with chains and in fetters; and he brake the bands, and was driven of the devil into the wilderness.)
- 462 32 And there was there an herd of many swine feeding on the mountain: and they besought him that he would suffer them to enter into them. And he suffered them.
- 463, 464 39 Return to thine own house, and shew how great things God hath done unto thee. And he went his way, and published throughout the whole city how great things Jesus had done unto him.
- 465 48 And he said unto her, Daughter, be of good comfort: thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace.
- 466, 467 50 But when Jesus heard it, he answered him, saying, Fear not: believe only, and she shall be made whole.

CLASS 406 LOS MANDAMIENTOS DE JESUCRISTO

- 468 54 And he put them all out, and took her by the hand, and called, saying, Maid, arise.
- 469 9:1 Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.
- 470 2 And he sent them to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick.
- 471 3 And he said unto them, Take nothing for your journey, neither staves, nor scrip, neither bread, neither money; neither have two coats apiece.
- 472 4 And whatsoever house ye enter into, there abide, and thence depart.
- 473 5 And whosoever will not receive you, when ye go out of that city, shake off the very dust from your feet for a testimony against them.
- 474 13 But he said unto them, Give ye them to eat. And they said, We have no more but five loaves and two fishes; except we should go and buy meat for all this people.
- 475 14 For they were about five thousand men. And he said to his disciples, Make them sit down by fifties in a company.
- 476 16 Then he took the five loaves and the two fishes, and looking up to heaven, he blessed them, and brake, and gave to the disciples to set before the multitude.
- 477 21 And he straitly charged them, and commanded them to tell no man that thing;
- 482 24 For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: but whosoever will lose his life for my sake, the same shall save it.
- 478, 479,
480, 481 23 And he said to them all, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me.
- 483 25 For what is a man advantaged, if he gain the whole world, and lose himself, or be cast away?
- 484 26 For whosoever shall be ashamed of me and of my words, of him shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he shall come in his own glory, and in his Father's, and of the holy angels.
- 485 41 And Jesus answering said, O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you, and suffer you? Bring thy son hither.
- 486 44 Let these sayings sink down into your ears: for the Son of man shall be delivered into the hands of men.
- 487 48 And said unto them, Whosoever shall receive this child in my name receiveth me: and whosoever shall receive me receiveth him that sent me: for he that is least among you all, the same shall be great.
- 488 50 And Jesus said unto him, Forbid him not: for he that is not against us is for us.
- 489 56 For the Son of man is not come to destroy men's lives, but to save them. And they went to another village.
- 490, 491 60 Jesus said unto him, Let the dead bury their dead: but go thou and preach the kingdom of God.

CLASS 406 LOS MANDAMIENTOS DE JESUCRISTO

- 492 62 And Jesus said unto him, No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.
- 493, 494 10:2 Therefore said he unto them, The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest.
- 495 3 Go your ways: behold, I send you forth as lambs among wolves.
- 496 4 Carry neither purse, nor scrip, nor shoes: and salute no man by the way.
- 497 5 And into whatsoever house ye enter, first say, Peace be to this house.
- 498 6 And if the son of peace be there, your peace shall rest upon it: if not, it shall turn to you again.
- 499, 500, 501 7 And in the same house remain, eating and drinking such things as they give: for the labourer is worthy of his hire. Go not from house to house.
- 502 8 And into whatsoever city ye enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you:
- 503, 504 9 And heal the sick that are therein, and say unto them, The kingdom of God is come nigh unto you.
- 512, 513 20 Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.
- 505 10 But into whatsoever city ye enter, and they receive you not, go your ways out into the streets of the same, and say,
- 506 11 Even the very dust of your city, which cleaveth on us, we do wipe off against you: notwithstanding be ye sure of this, that the kingdom of God is come nigh unto you.
- 507 12 But I say unto you, that it shall be more tolerable in that day for Sodom, than for that city.
- 508 13 Woe unto thee, Chorazin! woe unto thee, Bethsaida! for if the mighty works had been done in Tyre and Sidon, which have been done in you, they had a great while ago repented, sitting in sackcloth and ashes.
- 509 14 But it shall be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon at the judgment, than for you.
- 510 16 He that heareth you heareth me; and he that despiseth you despiseth me; and he that despiseth me despiseth him that sent me.
- 511 19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- 514 23 And he turned him unto his disciples, and said privately, Blessed are the eyes which see the things that ye see:
- 515 28 And he said unto him, Thou hast answered right: this do, and thou shalt live.
- 516 37 And he said, He that shewed mercy on him. Then said Jesus unto him, Go, and do thou likewise.
- 517 42 But one thing is needful: and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her.

CLASS 406 LOS MANDAMIENTOS DE JESUCRISTO

- 518 11:2 And he said unto them, When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth.
- 519, 520, 521 9 And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you.
- 522, 523, 524 10 For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.
- 525 17 But he, knowing their thoughts, said unto them, Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation; and a house divided against a house falleth.
- 526 23 He that is not with me is against me: and he that gathereth not with me scattereth.
- 527 28 But he said, Yea rather, blessed are they that hear the word of God, and keep it.
- 528 29 And when the people were gathered thick together, he began to say, This is an evil generation: they seek a sign; and there shall no sign be given it, but the sign of Jonas the prophet.
- 529 34 The light of the body is the eye: therefore when thine eye is single, thy whole body also is full of light; but when thine eye is evil, thy body also is full of darkness.
- 530 35 Take heed therefore that the light which is in thee be not darkness.
- 531 36 If thy whole body therefore be full of light, having no part dark, the whole shall be full of light, as when the bright shining of a candle doth give thee light.
- 532 41 But rather give alms of such things as ye have; and, behold, all things are clean unto you.
- 533, 534 42 But woe unto you, Pharisees! for ye tithe mint and rue and all manner of herbs, and pass over judgment and the love of God: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.
- 535 43 Woe unto you, Pharisees! for ye love the uppermost seats in the synagogues, and greetings in the Markets.
- 536 44 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye are as graves which appear not, and the men that walk over them are not aware of them.
- 537 46 And he said, Woe unto you also, ye lawyers! for ye lade men with burdens grievous to be borne, and ye yourselves touch not the burdens with one of your fingers.
- 538 47 Woe unto you! for ye build the sepulchres of the prophets, and your fathers killed them.
- 539 52 Woe unto you, lawyers! for ye have taken away the key of knowledge: ye entered not in yourselves, and them that were entering in ye hindered.
- 540 12:1 In the mean time, when there were gathered together an innumerable multitude of people, insomuch that they trode one upon another, he began to say unto his disciples first of all, Beware ye of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.
- 541 2 For there is nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; neither hid, that shall not be known.

CLASS 406 LOS MANDAMIENTOS DE JESUCRISTO

- 542 3 Therefore whatsoever ye have spoken in darkness shall be heard in the light; and that which ye have spoken in the ear in closets shall be proclaimed upon the housetops.
- 543 4 And I say unto you my friends, Be not afraid of them that kill the body, and after that have no more that they can do.
- 544 5 But I will forewarn you whom ye shall fear: Fear him, which after he hath killed hath power to cast into hell; yea, I say unto you, Fear him.
- 545 7 But even the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Fear not therefore: ye are of more value than many sparrows.
- 546 8 Also I say unto you, Whosoever shall confess me before men, him shall the Son of man also confess before the angels of God:
- 547 9 But he that denieth me before men shall be denied before the angels of God.
- 548 10 And whosoever shall speak a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but unto him that blasphemeth against the Holy Ghost it shall not be forgiven.
- 549, 550 11 And when they bring you unto the synagogues, and unto magistrates, and powers, take ye no thought how or what thing ye shall answer, or what ye shall say:
- 551 12 For the Holy Ghost shall teach you in the same hour what ye ought to say.
- 552, 553 15 And he said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth.
- 554 21 So is he that layeth up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God.
- 555, 556 22 And he said unto his disciples, Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat; neither for the body, what ye shall put on.
- 557 23 The life is more than meat, and the body is more than raiment.
- 558 24 Consider the ravens: for they neither sow nor reap; which neither have storehouse nor barn; and God feedeth them: how much more are ye better than the fowls?
- 559 25 And which of you with taking thought can add to his stature one cubit?
- 560 26 If ye then be not able to do that thing which is least, why take ye thought for the rest?
- 561 27 Consider the lilies how they grow: they toil not, they spin not; and yet I say unto you, that Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.
- 562 28 If then God so clothe the grass, which is to day in the field, and to morrow is cast into the oven; how much more will he clothe you, O ye of little faith?
- 563, 564, 565 29 And seek not ye what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink, neither be ye of doubtful mind.
- 566 30 For all these things do the nations of the world seek after: and your Father knoweth that ye have need of these things.
- 567 31 But rather seek ye the kingdom of God; and all these things shall be added unto you.

CLASS 406 LOS MANDAMIENTOS DE JESUCRISTO

- 568 32 Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.
- 569, 570, 571 33 Sell that ye have, and give alms; provide yourselves bags which wax not old, a treasure in the heavens that faileth not, where no thief approacheth, neither moth corrupteth.
- 572 34 For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.
- 573 35 Let your loins be girded about, and your lights burning;
- 574 36 And ye yourselves like unto men that wait for their lord, when he will return from the wedding; that when he cometh and knocketh, they may open unto him immediately.
- 575 37 Blessed are those servants, whom the lord when he cometh shall find watching: verily I say unto you, that he shall gird himself, and make them to sit down to meat, and will come forth and serve them.
- 576 38 And if he shall come in the second watch, or come in the third watch, and find them so, blessed are those servants.
- 577 40 Be ye therefore ready also: for the Son of man cometh at an hour when ye think not.
- 578 43 Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing.
- 579 44 Of a truth I say unto you, that he will make him ruler over all that he hath.
- 580 46 The lord of that servant will come in a day when he looketh not for him, and at an hour when he is not aware, and will cut him in sunder, and will appoint him his portion with the unbelievers.
- 581 47 And that servant, which knew his lord's will, and prepared not himself, neither did according to his will, shall be beaten with many stripes.
- 582 48 But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few stripes. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.
- 583 51 Suppose ye that I am come to give peace on earth? I tell you, Nay; but rather division:
- 584 58 When thou goest with thine adversary to the magistrate, as thou art in the way, give diligence that thou mayest be delivered from him; lest he hale thee to the judge, and the judge deliver thee to the officer, and the officer cast thee into prison.
- 585 59 I tell thee, thou shalt not depart thence, till thou hast paid the very last mite.
- 586 13:3 I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.
- 587 5 I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.
- 588 15 The Lord then answered him, and said, Thou hypocrite, doth not each one of you on the sabbath loose his ox or his ass from the stall, and lead him away to watering?
- 589 16 And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day?

CLASS 406 LOS MANDAMIENTOS DE JESUCRISTO

- 590 24 Strive to enter in at the strait gate: for many, I say unto you, will seek to enter in, and shall not be able.
- 591 34 O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, which killest the prophets, and stonest them that are sent unto thee; how often would I have gathered thy children together, as a hen doth gather her brood under her wings, and ye would not!
- 592 14:8 When thou art bidden of any man to a wedding, sit not down in the highest room; lest a more honourable man than thou be bidden of him;
- 593 10 But when thou art bidden, go and sit down in the lowest room; that when he that bade thee cometh, he may say unto thee, Friend, go up higher: then shalt thou have worship in the presence of them that sit at meat with thee.
- 594 11 For whosoever exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.
- 595 12 Then said he also to him that bade him, When thou makest a dinner or a supper, call not thy friends, nor thy brethren, neither thy kinsmen, nor thy rich neighbours; lest they also bid thee again, and a recompence be made thee.
- 596, 597, 598,
599 13 But when thou makest a feast, call the poor, the maimed, the lame, the blind:
- 600 14 And thou shalt be blessed; for they cannot recompense thee: for thou shalt be recompensed at the resurrection of the just.
- 601 17 And sent his servant at supper time to say to them that were bidden, Come; for all things are now ready.
- 602 23 And the lord said unto the servant, Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled.
- 603 24 For I say unto you, That none of those men which were bidden shall taste of my supper.
- 604 26 If any man come to me, and hate not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be my disciple.
- 605 27 And whosoever doth not bear his cross, and come after me, cannot be my disciple.
- 606 33 So likewise, whosoever he be of you that forsaketh not all that he hath, he cannot be my disciple.
- 607 34 Salt is good: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be seasoned?
- 608 15:6 And when he cometh home, he calleth together his friends and neighbours, saying unto them, Rejoice with me; for I have found my sheep which was lost.
- 609 7 I say unto you, that likewise joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that repenteth, more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no repentance.
- 610 9 And when she hath found it, she calleth her friends and her neighbours together, saying, Rejoice with me; for I have found the piece which I had lost.
- 611 10 Likewise, I say unto you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner that repenteth.

CLASS 406 LOS MANDAMIENTOS DE JESUCRISTO

- 611 22 But the father said to his servants, Bring forth the best robe, and put it on him; and put a ring on his hand, and shoes on his feet:
- 612 16:9 And I say unto you, Make to yourselves friends of the mammon of unrighteousness; that, when ye fail, they may receive you into everlasting habitations.
- 613 10 He that is faithful in that which is least is faithful also in much: and he that is unjust in the least is unjust also in much.
- 614 11 If therefore ye have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches?
- 615 12 And if ye have not been faithful in that which is another man's, who shall give you that which is your own?
- 616 13 No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.
- 617 15 And he said unto them, Ye are they which justify yourselves before men; but God knoweth your hearts: for that which is highly esteemed among men is abomination in the sight of God.
- 618 16 The law and the prophets were until John: since that time the kingdom of God is preached, and every man presseth into it.
- 619 17 And it is easier for heaven and earth to pass, than one tittle of the law to fail.
- 620 18 Whosoever putteth away his wife, and marrieth another, committeth adultery: and whosoever marrieth her that is put away from her husband committeth adultery.
- 621 17:1 Then said he unto the disciples, It is impossible but that offences will come: but woe unto him, through whom they come!
- 622 2 It were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he cast into the sea, than that he should offend one of these little ones.
- 623, 624, 625 3 Take heed to yourselves: If thy brother trespass against thee, rebuke him; and if he repent, forgive him.
- 626 4 And if he trespass against thee seven times in a day, and seven times in a day turn again to thee, saying, I repent; thou shalt forgive him.
- 627 6 And the Lord said, If ye had faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye might say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey you.
- 628 10 So likewise ye, when ye shall have done all those things which are commanded you, say, We are unprofitable servants: we have done that which was our duty to do.
- 629 14 And when he saw them, he said unto them, Go shew yourselves unto the priests. And it came to pass, that, as they went, they were cleansed.
- 630 19 And he said unto him, Arise, go thy way: thy faith hath made thee whole.

CLASS 406 LOS MANDAMIENTOS DE JESUCRISTO

- 631 20 And when he was demanded of the Pharisees, when the kingdom of God should come, he answered them and said, The kingdom of God cometh not with observation:
- 632 21 Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, the kingdom of God is within you.
- 633, 634 23 And they shall say to you, See here; or, see there: go not after them, nor follow them.
- 635 24 For as the lightning, that lighteneth out of the one part under heaven, shineth unto the other part under heaven; so shall also the Son of man be in his day.
- 636, 637 31 In that day, he which shall be upon the housetop, and his stuff in the house, let him not come down to take it away: and he that is in the field, let him likewise not return back.
- 638 32 Remember Lot's wife.
- 639 33 Whosoever shall seek to save his life shall lose it; and whosoever shall lose his life shall preserve it.
- 640 18:1 And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;
- 641 6 And the Lord said, Hear what the unjust judge saith.
- 642 7 And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them?
- 643 8 I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth?
- 644, 645 14 I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.
- 646, 647 16 But Jesus called them unto him, and said, Suffer little children to come unto me, and forbid them not: for of such is the kingdom of God.
- 648 17 Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not receive the kingdom of God as a little child shall in no wise enter therein.
- 649 22 Now when Jesus heard these things, he said unto him, Yet lackest thou one thing: sell all that thou hast, and distribute unto the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, follow me.
- 650 24 And when Jesus saw that he was very sorrowful, he said, How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the kingdom of God!
- 651 25 For it is easier for a camel to go through a needle's eye, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God.
- 652 27 And he said, The things which are impossible with men are possible with God.
- 653 30 Who shall not receive manifold more in this present time, and in the world to come life everlasting.
- 654 40 And Jesus stood, and commanded him to be brought unto him: and when he was come near, he asked him,

- 655 42 And Jesus said unto him, Receive thy sight: thy faith hath saved thee.
- 656, 657 19:5 And when Jesus came to the place, he looked up, and saw him, and said unto him, Zacchaeus, make haste, and come down; for to day I must abide at thy house.
- 658 10 For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.
- 659 13 And he called his ten servants, and delivered them ten pounds, and said unto them, Occupy till I come.
- 660 15 And it came to pass, that when he was returned, having received the kingdom, then he commanded these servants to be called unto him, to whom he had given the money, that he might know how much every man had gained by trading.
- 661 17 And he said unto him, Well, thou good servant: because thou hast been faithful in a very little, have thou authority over ten cities.
- 662 19 And he said likewise to him, Be thou also over five cities.
- 663 22 And he saith unto him, Out of thine own mouth will I judge thee, thou wicked servant. Thou knewest that I was an austere man, taking up that I laid not down, and reaping that I did not sow:
- 664 23 Wherefore then gavest not thou my money into the bank, that at my coming I might have required mine own with usury?
- 665 24 And he said unto them that stood by, Take from him the pound, and give it to him that hath ten pounds.
- 666 26 For I say unto you, That unto every one which hath shall be given; and from him that hath not, even that he hath shall be taken away from him.
- 667 27 But those mine enemies, which would not that I should reign over them, bring hither, and slay them before me.
- 668, 669, 670 30 Saying, Go ye into the village over against you; in the which at your entering ye shall find a colt tied, whereon yet never man sat: loose him, and bring him hither.
- 671 31 And if any man ask you, Why do ye loose him? thus shall ye say unto him, Because the Lord hath need of him.
- 672 46 Saying unto them, It is written, My house is the house of prayer: but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- 673 20:17 And he beheld them, and said, What is this then that is written, The stone which the builders rejected, the same is become the head of the corner?
- 674 18 Whosoever shall fall upon that stone shall be broken; but on whomsoever it shall fall, it will grind him to powder.
- 675 24 Shew me a penny. Whose image and superscription hath it? They answered and said, Caesar's.
- 676 25 And he said unto them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which be Caesar's, and unto God the things which be God's.

CLASS 406 LOS MANDAMIENTOS DE JESUCRISTO

- 677 35 But they which shall be accounted worthy to obtain that world, and the resurrection from the dead, neither marry, nor are given in marriage:
- 678 38 For he is not a God of the dead, but of the living: for all live unto him.
- 679 46 Beware of the scribes, which desire to walk in long robes, and love greetings in the Markets, and the highest seats in the synagogues, and the chief rooms at feasts;
- 680 21:3 And he said, Of a truth I say unto you, that this poor widow hath cast in more than they all:
- 681, 682 8 And he said, Take heed that ye be not deceived: for many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and the time draweth near: go ye not therefore after them.
- 683 9 But when ye shall hear of wars and commotions, be not terrified: for these things must first come to pass; but the end is not by and by.
- 684 14 Settle it therefore in your hearts, not to meditate before what ye shall answer:
- 685 15 For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist.
- 686 19 In your patience possess ye your souls.
- 687 20 And when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies, then know that the desolation thereof is nigh.
- 688, 689, 690 21 Then let them which are in Judaea flee to the mountains; and let them which are in the midst of it depart out; and let not them that are in the countries enter thereinto.
- 691 23 But woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck, in those days! for there shall be great distress in the land, and wrath upon this people.
- 692 28 And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh.
- 693 31 So likewise ye, when ye see these things come to pass, know ye that the kingdom of God is nigh at hand.
- 694 32 Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass away, till all be fulfilled.
- 695 33 Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away.
- 696 34 And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares.
- 697, 698 36 Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man.
- 699 22:8 And he sent Peter and John, saying, Go and prepare us the passover, that we may eat.
- 700 10 And he said unto them, Behold, when ye are entered into the city, there shall a man meet you, bearing a pitcher of water; follow him into the house where he entereth in.

CLASS 406 LOS MANDAMIENTOS DE JESUCRISTO

- 701 11 And ye shall say unto the goodman of the house, The Master saith unto thee, Where is the guestchamber, where I shall eat the passover with my disciples?
- 702 12 And he shall shew you a large upper room furnished: there make ready.
- 703 17 And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, Take this, and divide it among yourselves:
- 704 19 And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake it, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.
- 705 22 And truly the Son of man goeth, as it was determined: but woe unto that man by whom he is betrayed!
- 706 26 But ye shall not be so: but he that is greatest among you, let him be as the younger; and he that is chief, as he that doth serve.
- 707 32 But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.
- 708 36 Then said he unto them, But now, he that hath a purse, let him take it, and likewise his scrip: and he that hath no sword, let him sell his garment, and buy one.
- 709 40 And when he was at the place, he said unto them, Pray that ye enter not into temptation.
- 710, 711 46 And said unto them, Why sleep ye? rise and pray, lest ye enter into temptation.
- 712 51 And Jesus answered and said, Suffer ye thus far. And he touched his ear, and healed him.
- 713, 714, 715 23:28 But Jesus turning unto them said, Daughters of Jerusalem, weep not for me, but weep for yourselves, and for your children.
- 716 24:36 And as they thus spake, Jesus himself stood in the midst of them, and saith unto them, Peace be unto you.
- 717, 718 39 Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see; for a spirit hath not flesh and bones, as ye see me have.
- 720 46 And said unto them, Thus it is written, and thus it behoved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day:
- 721 47 And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.
- 722 48 And ye are witnesses of these things.
- 723 49 And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

- 724 1:39 He saith unto them, Come and see. They came and saw where he dwelt, and abode with him that day: for it was about the tenth hour.
- 725 43 The day following Jesus would go forth into Galilee, and findeth Philip, and saith unto him, Follow me.
- 726 2:7 Jesus saith unto them, Fill the waterpots with water. And they filled them up to the brim.
- 727, 728 8 And he saith unto them, Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast. And they bare it.
- 729, 730 16 And said unto them that sold doves, Take these things hence; make not my Father's house an house of merchandise.
- 731 3:3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.
- 732 5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.
- 733 7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- 734 15 That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life.
- 735 16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- 736 17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.
- 737 18 He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.
- 738 4:7 There cometh a woman of Samaria to draw water: Jesus saith unto her, Give me to drink.
- 739 14 But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.
- 740 16 Jesus saith unto her, Go, call thy husband, and come hither.
- 741 22 Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews.
- 742 23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.
- 743 24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.
- 744 34 Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work.
- 745, 746 35 Say not ye, There are yet four months, and then cometh harvest? behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest.

CLASS 406 LOS MANDAMIENTOS DE JESUCRISTO

- 747 36 And he that reapeth receiveth wages, and gathereth fruit unto life eternal: that both he that soweth and he that reapeth may rejoice together.
- 748 44 For Jesus himself testified, that a prophet hath no honour in his own country.
- 749 50 Jesus saith unto him, Go thy way; thy son liveth. And the man believed the word that Jesus had spoken unto him, and he went his way.
- 750, 751, 752 5:8 Jesus saith unto him, Rise, take up thy bed, and walk.
- 753 14 Afterward Jesus findeth him in the temple, and said unto him, Behold, thou art made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee.
- 754 17 But Jesus answered them, My Father worketh hitherto, and I work.
- 755 19 Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.
- 756 20 For the Father loveth the Son, and sheweth him all things that himself doeth: and he will shew him greater works than these, that ye may marvel.
- 757 he will. 21 For as the Father raiseth up the dead, and quickeneth them; even so the Son quickeneth whom
- 758 22 For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:
- 759 23 That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him.
- 760 24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.
- 761 26 For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself;
- 762 27 And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man.
- 763 28 Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice,
- 764 29 And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.
- 765 30 I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me.
- 766 39 Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me.
- 767 40 And ye will not come to me, that ye might have life.
- 768 6:10 And Jesus said, Make the men sit down. Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, in number about five thousand.

CLASS 406 LOS MANDAMIENTOS DE JESUCRISTO

- 769 12 When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost.
- 770 20 But he saith unto them, It is I; be not afraid.
- 771 27 Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath God the Father sealed.
- 772 29 Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.
- 773 35 And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.
- 774 37 All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out.
- 775 38 For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.
- 776 39 And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.
- 777 40 And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.
- 778 43 Jesus therefore answered and said unto them, Murmur not among yourselves.
- 779 44 No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day.
- 780 47 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life.
- 781 48 I am that bread of life.
- 782 51 I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.
- 783, 784 53 Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you.
- 785 56 He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him.
- 786 57 As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me.
- 787 65 And he said, Therefore said I unto you, that no man can come unto me, except it were given unto him of my Father.
- 788 7:16 Jesus answered them, and said, My doctrine is not mine, but his that sent me.
- 789 17 If any man will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God, or whether I speak of myself.

CLASS 406 LOS MANDAMIENTOS DE JESUCRISTO

- 790 18 He that speaketh of himself seeketh his own glory: but he that seeketh his glory that sent him, the same is true, and no unrighteousness is in him.
- 791, 792 24 Judge not according to the appearance, but judge righteous judgment.
- 793 37 In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.
- 794 38 He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.
- 795 8:7 So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.
- 796 11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.
- 797 12 Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.
- 798 24 I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins.
- 799 29 And he that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone; for I do always those things that please him.
- 800 31 Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed;
- 801 32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.
- 802 34 Jesus answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin.
- 803 36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.
- 804 42 Jesus said unto them, If God were your Father, ye would love me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of myself, but he sent me.
- 805 47 He that is of God heareth God's words: ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God.
- 806 51 Verily, verily, I say unto you, If a man keep my saying, he shall never see death.
- 807 58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.
- 808 9:4 I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.
- 809 5 As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.
- 810 7 And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, Sent.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing.

CLASS 406 LOS MANDAMIENTOS DE JESUCRISTO

- 811 41 Jesus said unto them, If ye were blind, ye should have no sin: but now ye say, We see; therefore your sin remaineth.
- 812 10:7 Then said Jesus unto them again, Verily, verily, I say unto you, I am the door of the sheep.
- 813 9 I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.
- 814 11 I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.
- 815 14 I am the good shepherd, and know my sheep, and am known of mine.
- 816 18 No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of my Father.
- 817 27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:
- 818 28 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.
- 819 29 My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.
- 820 30 I and my Father are one.
- 821 11:25 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:
- 822 26 And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?
- 823 43 And when he thus had spoken, he cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth.
- 824, 825 44 And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go.
- 826 12:7 Then said Jesus, Let her alone: against the day of my burying hath she kept this.
- 827 24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.
- 828 25 He that loveth his life shall lose it; and he that hateth his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal.
- 829 26 If any man serve me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will my Father honour.
- 830 32 And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all men unto me.
- 831 35 Then Jesus said unto them, Yet a little while is the light with you. Walk while ye have the light, lest darkness come upon you: for he that walketh in darkness knoweth not whither he goeth.
- 832 36 While ye have light, believe in the light, that ye may be the children of light. These things spake Jesus, and departed, and did hide himself from them.

- 833 44 Jesus cried and said, He that believeth on me, believeth not on me, but on him that sent me.
- 834 45 And he that seeth me seeth him that sent me.
- 835 46 I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness.
- 836 47 And if any man hear my words, and believe not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world.
- 837 48 He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day.
- 838 49 For I have not spoken of myself; but the Father which sent me, he gave me a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak.
- 839 50 And I know that his commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto me, so I speak.
- 840 13:10 Jesus saith to him, He that is washed needeth not save to wash his feet, but is clean every whit: and ye are clean, but not all.
- 841 14 If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet.
- 842 15 For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you.
- 843 16 Verily, verily, I say unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord; neither he that is sent greater than he that sent him.
- 844 17 If ye know these things, happy are ye if ye do them.
- 845 20 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that receiveth whomsoever I send receiveth me; and he that receiveth me receiveth him that sent me.
- 846 27 And after the sop Satan entered into him. Then said Jesus unto him, That thou doest, do quickly.
- 847 34 A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.
- 848, 849 14:1 Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.
- 850 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.
- 851 6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- 852 9 Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father?
- 853 11 Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake.
- 854 13 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

- 855 14 If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.
- 856 15 If ye love me, keep my commandments.
- 857 18 I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.
- 858 21 He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.
- 859 23 Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.
- 860 26 But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.
- 861, 862 27 Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.
- 863 31 But that the world may know that I love the Father; and as the Father gave me commandment, even so I do. Arise, let us go hence.
- 864 15:4 Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.
- 865 5 I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.
- 866 7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.
- 867 8 Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples.
- 868 9 As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love.
- 869 10 If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.
- 870 11 These things have I spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full.
- 871 12 This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you.
- 872 13 Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.
- 873 14 Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you.
- 874 16 Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.
- 875 17 These things I command you, that ye love one another.

- 876 20 Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also.
- 877 16:7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.
- 878 8 And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- 879 13 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.
- 880 14 He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you.
- 881 20 Verily, verily, I say unto you, That ye shall weep and lament, but the world shall rejoice: and ye shall be sorrowful, but your sorrow shall be turned into joy.
- 882 22 And ye now therefore have sorrow: but I will see you again, and your heart shall rejoice, and your joy no man taketh from you.
- 883 23 And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you.
- 884 24 Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.
- 885 26 At that day ye shall ask in my name: and I say not unto you, that I will pray the Father for you:
- 886 33 These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.
- 887 17:3 And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent.
- 888 15 I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil.
- 889 17 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.
- 890 18 As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world.
- 891 21 That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.
- 892 18:8 Jesus answered, I have told you that I am he: if therefore ye seek me, let these go their way:
- 893 11 Then said Jesus unto Peter, Put up thy sword into the sheath: the cup which my Father hath given me, shall I not drink it?
- 894 23 Jesus answered him, If I have spoken evil, bear witness of the evil: but if well, why smitest thou me?
- 895 19:11 Jesus answered, Thou couldest have no power at all against me, except it were given thee from above: therefore he that delivered me unto thee hath the greater sin.

- 896 26 When Jesus therefore saw his mother, and the disciple standing by, whom he loved, he saith unto his mother, Woman, behold thy son!

- 901 22 And when he had said this, he breathed on them, and saith unto them, Receive ye the Holy Ghost:
- 902 23 Whose soever sins ye remit, they are remitted unto them; and whose soever sins ye retain, they are retained.
- 903 26 And after eight days again his disciples were within, and Thomas with them: then came Jesus, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, Peace be unto you.
- 904, 905, 906,
907, 908, 909 27 Then saith he to Thomas, reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing.
- 910 29 Jesus saith unto him, Thomas, because thou hast seen me, thou hast believed: blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed.
- 911 21:6 And he said unto them, Cast the net on the right side of the ship, and ye shall find. They cast therefore, and now they were not able to draw it for the multitude of fishes.
- 912 10 Jesus saith unto them, Bring of the fish which ye have now caught.
- 913, 914 12 Jesus saith unto them, Come and dine. And none of the disciples durst ask him, Who art thou? knowing that it was the Lord.
- 915 15 So when they had dined, Jesus saith to Simon Peter, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me more than these? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my lambs.
- 916 16 He saith to him again the second time, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my sheep.
- 917 17 He saith unto him the third time, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me? Peter was grieved because he said unto him the third time, Lovest thou me? And he said unto him, Lord, thou knowest all things; thou knowest that I love thee. Jesus saith unto him, Feed my sheep.
- 918 19 This spake he, signifying by what death he should glorify God. And when he had spoken this, he saith unto him, Follow me.
- 919 22 Jesus saith unto him, If I will that he tarry till I come, what is that to thee? follow thou me.

- 920 1:1 The former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach,
- 921 2 Until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the Holy Ghost had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen:
- 922 3 To whom also he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God:

- 924 5 For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence.
- 925 8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.
- 926 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.
- 927 3:6 Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.
- 928 19 Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord;
- 929 4:10 Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole.
- 930 20 For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard.
- 931 5:29 Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men.
- 932 6:3 Wherefore, brethren, look ye out among you seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business.
- 933 8:22 Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee.
- 934 26 And the angel of the Lord spake unto Philip, saying, Arise, and go toward the south unto the way that goeth down from Jerusalem unto Gaza, which is desert.
- 935 29 Then the Spirit said unto Philip, Go near, and join thyself to this chariot.
- 936, 937 18:9 Then spake the Lord to Paul in the night by a vision, Be not afraid, but speak, and hold not thy peace:
- 938 10 For I am with thee, and no man shall set on thee to hurt thee: for I have much people in this city.

- 939 20:35 I have shewed you all things, how that so labouring ye ought to support the weak, and to remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he said, It is more blessed to give than to receive.
- 940 22:10 And I said, What shall I do, Lord? And the Lord said unto me, Arise, and go into Damascus; and there it shall be told thee of all things which are appointed for thee to do.
- 941, 942 17 And it came to pass, that, when I was come again to Jerusalem, even while I prayed in the temple, I was in a trance;
18 And saw him saying unto me, Make haste, and get thee quickly out of Jerusalem: for they will not receive thy testimony concerning me.
19 And I said, Lord, they know that I imprisoned and beat in every synagogue them that believed on thee:
20 And when the blood of thy martyr Stephen was shed, I also was standing by, and consenting unto his death, and kept the raiment of them that slew him.
- 943 21 And he said unto me, Depart: for I will send thee far hence unto the Gentiles.
- 944, 945 26:15 And I said, Who art thou, Lord? And he said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest.
16 But rise, and stand upon thy feet: for I have appeared unto thee for this purpose, to make thee a minister and a witness both of these things which thou hast seen, and of those things in the which I will appear unto thee;
17 Delivering thee from the people, and from the Gentiles, unto whom now I send thee,
18 To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.

- 946 1:3 Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand.
- 947 1:11 Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send it unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.
- 948 1:19 Write the things which thou hast seen, and the things which are, and the things which shall be hereafter;
- 949 2:1 Unto the angel of the church of Ephesus write; These things saith he that holdeth the seven stars in his right hand, who walketh in the midst of the seven golden candlesticks;
2 I know thy works, and thy labour, and thy patience, and how thou canst not bear them which are evil: and thou hast tried them which say they are apostles, and are not, and hast found them liars:
3 And hast borne, and hast patience, and for my name's sake hast laboured, and hast not fainted.
4 Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because thou hast left thy first love.
- 950 5 Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.
6 But this thou hast, that thou hatest the deeds of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate.
- 951 7 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.
- 952 8 And unto the angel of the church in Smyrna write; These things saith the first and the last, which was dead, and is alive;
9 I know thy works, and tribulation, and poverty, (but thou art rich) and I know the blasphemy of them which say they are Jews, and are not, but are the synagogue of Satan.
- 953, 954 10 Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.
- 955 11 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death.
- 956 12 And to the angel of the church in Pergamos write; These things saith he which hath the sharp sword with two edges;
13 I know thy works, and where thou dwellest, even where Satan's seat is: and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas was my faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where Satan dwelleth.
14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.
15 So hast thou also them that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate.
- 957 16 Repent; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth.

- 958 17 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it.
- 959 18 And unto the angel of the church in Thyatira write; These things saith the Son of God, who hath his eyes like unto a flame of fire, and his feet are like fine brass;
19 I know thy works, and charity, and service, and faith, and thy patience, and thy works; and the last to be more than the first.
20 Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols.
21 And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not.
22 Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds.
23 And I will kill her children with death; and all the churches shall know that I am he which searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you according to your works.
24 But unto you I say, and unto the rest in Thyatira, as many as have not this doctrine, and which have not known the depths of Satan, as they speak; I will put upon you none other burden.
- 960 25 But that which ye have already hold fast till I come.
26 And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:
27 And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father.
28 And I will give him the morning star.
- 961 29 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.
- 962 3:1 And unto the angel of the church in Sardis write; These things saith he that hath the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars; I know thy works, that thou hast a name that thou livest, and art dead.
- 963, 964 2 Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die: for I have not found thy works perfect before God.
- 965, 966, 967 3 Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee.
4 Thou hast a few names even in Sardis which have not defiled their garments; and they shall walk with me in white: for they are worthy.
5 He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.
- 968 6 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.
- 969 7 And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith he that is holy, he that is true, he that hath the key of David, he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth;
8 I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name.
9 Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee.
10 Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.

- 970, 971 11 Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown.
12 Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon him my new name.
- 972 13 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.
- 973 14 And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God;
15 I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot.
16 So then because thou art Lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.
17 Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:
- 974 18 I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.
- 975, 976 19 As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent.
20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.
21 To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.
- 977 22 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.
- 978 4:1 After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter.
- 979 10:8 And the voice which I heard from heaven spake unto me again, and said, Go and take the little book which is open in the hand of the angel which standeth upon the sea and upon the earth.
- 980 22:6 And he said unto me, These sayings are faithful and true: and the Lord God of the holy prophets sent his angel to shew unto his servants the things which must shortly be done.
- 981 7 Behold, I come quickly: blessed is he that keepeth the sayings of the prophecy of this book.
- 982 9 Then saith he unto me, See thou do it not: for I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren the prophets, and of them which keep the sayings of this book: worship God.
10 And he saith unto me, Seal not the sayings of the prophecy of this book: for the time is at hand.
11 He that is unjust, let him be unjust still: and he which is filthy, let him be filthy still: and he that is righteous, let him be righteous still: and he that is holy, let him be holy still.
12 And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.
13 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.
- 983 14 Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.
15 For without are dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie.
16 I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star.

- 984, 985 17 And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.

19 And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.

Conclusion

Ecclesiastes 12:13 says this: Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man.

We observe – and teach others to observe (by example) the commandments of Jesus Christ (see Matthew 28:18-20). We can say, as New Testament believers, this is our whole duty. This is the Doctrine of Christ. For the student making his list of commandments to complete this objective, he has liberty in how to do this work. In the above I have listed them in order from Matthew to Revelation, and I also provided lists based on topical subjects. But there are many other ways a student can arrange to study these commandments.

Here are some ideas:

- Make a list of those commandments from the apostles that we do have a record of Jesus commanding.
- Make a list of those commandments from the apostles where they repeated or emphasized the commandments of the Saviour.
- Separate commandments by big topics – holiness, love, service, faith, etc.
- List the commandments by number of repetitions – those repeated most often to maybe those only mentioned once.
- List the commandments that are considered subsets of greater commandment. For example, Love Commandment Doctrine encompasses all the commandments of Christ. Then this is divided into two: loving God and loving man. The, under each make a list, continuing from the general to the specific.

The student should consider a few things when preparing his list:

1. How can this be profitable to others?
2. Following the leadership of the Holy Ghost in prayer for ideas
3. Arranging the work in a teachable, easy to understand format.

In summary, the best use of a preacher's time is to learn, observe, and teach Jesus' commandments. We need to be expert in these.
