II. OTHER INFORMATION

- A. All Churches can publish but not all churches can print.
 - 1. To be a printing church - a congregation of 100 or more.
 - 2. One ministry can out ~~weigh~~ ^{weigh} the other
 - a. Amount of assets to draw from, men, money, materials.
 - b. Importance: Bus verses Printing
 - 3. Must be a man to do the work.
 - 4. 50 Churches publish the Word of God is an ideal number
 - a. 50 major trade languages will reach all 156 nations.
 - b. 50 churches - 50 states each state produces
- B. Approximately 10 other churches are involved in some basic step of publishing.
- C. 2000 churches give to Scriptures in the form of Publish Grants or monthly support.
- D. Over 1000 Tons has been produced in the last 10 years
- E. Right now we have the church printing press capability to produce 1000 tons per month

I. MULTILITH 1250

A. Basic needs

1. Ink
2. Blanket wash
3. Fountain solution
4. Cotton pads
5. Ink knife
6. Tools - screwdriver, hammer

B. Capability ($8\frac{1}{2}$ x 11 standard, $8\frac{1}{2}$ x 14 max.)

1. 4 pages -- $8\frac{1}{2}$ x 11 produces a $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " booklet
2. 8 pages -- $8\frac{1}{2}$ x 14 produces a 7" x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " booklet
3. 4 pages -- $8\frac{1}{2}$ x 11 produces a 7" x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " booklet
4. 8 pages -- $8\frac{1}{2}$ x 11 produces a $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " booklet

Note: These figures indicate the basic capacity and number of pages a multilith 1250 press can produce.

C. Maximum Production: 1-4 pages Sig. $8\frac{1}{2}$ x 11

1. 3,000-5,000 imp per hour 4,000 average
2. This produces 300-32 page books per hour
3. It takes 8-4 page-Sig. to produce a 32 page book.
4. Production of New Testament would take 38 sig. and 64 one-side plates, or 32 two-side plates.
5. Approximate cost for paper is \$20.00 per hour for paper to run machine.

6. Possible production of 32 New Testament per hour -
1 every 2 minutes, ideally
7. The press and equipment set up cost new \$12,000 to \$14,000

II. NOTE:

Catholics have a press that produces 52,000 32 page magazines per hour. They have the largest chain of papers in the world.

Jehovah Witnesses have the largest printing press in the world.

INTRODUCTION:

"But now is made manifest, and by the scriptures of the prophets, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, made known to all nations for the obedience of faith:" (Rom. 16:26)

"But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth."
(Acts 1:8)

I. "IN JERUSALEM"

- A. Local area (Wisconsin)
- B. Gospel and New Testament for free distribution

II. "ALL JUDAEA"

- A. Our Nation (United States)
- B. Gospel and New Testament for other churches and home missions.

III. "IN SAMARIA"

- A. Near Nations (Mexico, Canada, Cuba)
- B. Gospel of New Testament with some whole Bibles
- C. Scriptures for missionaries and churches in the major foreign trade language.

IV. "THE UTTERMOST"

A. Far Nations or where Christ is not named.

"Yea, so have I strived to preach the gospel, not where Christ was named, lest I should build upon another man's foundation: But as it is written, To whom he was not spoken of, they shall see: and they that have not heard shall understand." Rom. 15: 21,22

B. Publication in tribal language in unevangelized areas.

Conclusion: Acts 1:8 is to preserve, print, present, and plant the Word of God in a field where God is not known.

Special Note: THE REGIONS BEYOND

The World Belt of Unbelief

This is a regional area of the earth lying between the Tropic of Capricorn, North 30° to South 20° of the Equator, the Tropic of Cancer. This belt is mostly populated with people of little Biblical belief, most yet not having received or heard the Word of God. This type of unbelief, unreached area, is also predominate North of the 60° line.

- B. There is a commission of God for the church to print the Word of God.
- C. The purpose is to produce the Word of God to those who have never heard the Word of God.

IV. THIS IS A FAITH MINISTRY.

- B. Supported by the local church and its people.

V. MISSIONARIES NEED THE WORD OF GOD FOR THEIR PEOPLE.

D. Tons of paper are needed NOW for the publishing and distribution of the Scriptures.

E. Free distribution of Scriptures to all nations without sale or price through Independent Baptist Churches and Missionaries.

INTRODUCTION: A ministry is something you are willing to do for God without necessarily being paid. A job is what one does for pay. We often try to do God's business man's way. We should do God's business His way.

I. PREREQUISITE OF SCRIPTURE PRINTING IS MONEY FOR THE WORK FROM INTER-CHURCH ACTIVITY (YOU BEING THE SERVANT).

It cost approximately \$3,000 to produce one ton of Scripture.

II. GENERAL USE OF FUNDS

A. Material cost.

B. Production costs

1. Equipment maintenance, replacement.

C. Distribution.

1. Transportation of product during production.
2. Transportation of finished product to destination.

III. PRACTICAL PRESS SIZES AND COST

INTRODUCTION: Maximum paper size indicates press size or impression cylinder size

A. 10" x 15" Signature

1. One side = \$100.00 per day production cost. 1 ton/monthly.

2. Perfector = \$200.00 per day production cost. 2 ton/monthly.
- B. 11" x 17" Signature
 1. One side = \$200.00 per day production cost. 2 ton/monthly.
 2. Perfector - \$400.00 per day production cost. 4 ton/monthly.
- C. 17" x 22" Signature
 1. One side = \$250.00 to \$400.00 per day cost. 6 ton/monthly.
 2. Perfector = \$300.00 per day production cost. 12 ton/monthly --
doubled.
- D. Roll Web Press. 32" signature roll
 1. Perfector - 135 Tons/monthly at \$4,800.00/100 production cost
daily.
- E. These above figures are variable.
- F. Three divisions in the work.
 1. Material - Raising funds.
 2. Production - Printing.
 3. Distribution - Trips, mailings.
- G. New Testament to Africa Example:
 - .75 Cost of New Testament
 - .83 Postage - Book rate
 - .10 Envelope\$1.68 Total Cost.

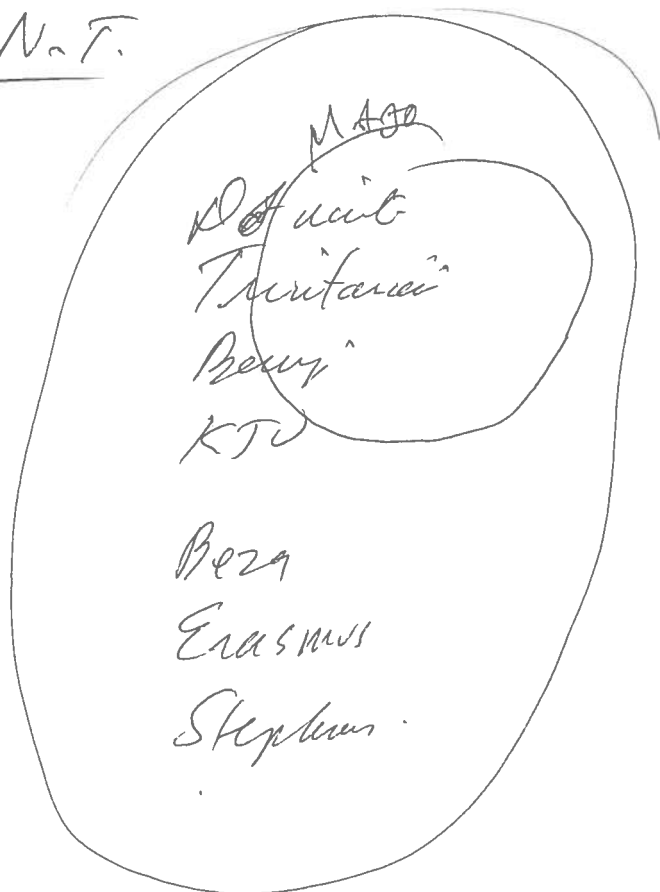
