THE WHOLE WORLD PLAN

I. Why is the world not being reached with the Gospel?

- because of disobedience to God's call.
- because of convenience at home.
- because of comfort at home.
- because of money greed.
- because of many looking for man's position rather than God's will.

*and Fear of Man  
Mar. 29:25*

- Personal notes - God's plan is always simple *not greivous*
- God had to use persecution on the early church in Jerusalem to get the people to go to all nations.
  - God's will is for us to accept His command to go willingly, but if we don't go, God will force us to go through persecution.
  - Two out of three missionaries drop out after their first term.

1. We must know and be in the will of God. 1 Chron. 4:9-10
  2. We must be Holy Spirit led. Acts 16:6-12
  3. We must work together as a team, knowing our part and doing it. God's looking for servants.
  4. We must build on the right foundation.
    - 1 Cor. 3:11, Jesus Christ the only foundation for success in God's work.
    - 2 Cor. 10:4, not carnal means.

Facts to Consider:

1. 90% of all Christians come from the 9% English speaking people.
2. 94% of the preachers are preaching to the 9% English speaking people.
3. 96% of all money gathered goes to the 9% English speaking people.
4. 97% of all printed material goes back to the 9% English speaking people in the forms of Christian books.

II. Natural Divisions of people found in the Bible.

A. There are natural lines of divisions of people. (Gen. 10:1).

- Shem - the line of Christ - yellow or orientals
- Ham - the line of the Black people - Africans
- Japeth - the line of the white people - Europeans

Note: God is interested in the needs of people not church buildings.

B. There are New Testament divisions (1 Cor. 10:32)

- Jews
- Gentiles
- the church of God

Note: We must know and know how to use the Bible in light of the differeint backgrounds of the people we work with.

- C. There are natural class divisions of people (Rom. 1:14)  
- Greeks - wise  
- Barbarians - unwise  
Note: We must be concerned with people's customs & cultural backgrounds.
- D. There are natural location divisions (Acts 1:8)  
- Jerusalem - home (Stevens Point, Wisconsin, United States)  
- Judea - Mexico & Canada  
- Samaria - Central America, etc.  
- Uttermost - Where Christ has not yet been named (Rom. 15:20).
- E. <sup>Supernatural</sup> Natural divisions according to Time and Equipment (Matt. 16:18).  
(Our source, the Word of God, will open all kinds of doors.  
The gates of hell shall not prevail against the church.)  
We need to build a team-don't stifle your team.

- F. The natural division for now & eternity (Rom. 10:13-17)  
- The saved - by faith, through the Word of God, by preachers.  
- The lost - by no witness, by no Word of God, by no preachers.  
Note: The answer is found in Rom. 16:26, by faithful, obedient servants keeping the everlasting commandment of God to make the Word of God manifested.
- G. The natural division according to Languages (Rev. 5:9; Acts 1:8)  
- of every tongue - language  
- there are 50 basic trade languages  
- 75% of the world can be reached by English, French, and Spanish.  
- yet there are many of the uttermost that need to be reached even where the name of Christ has not yet been once named (Rom. 15:20).

Knowing all these facts is not enough. We must know the commandment and the Holy Spirit must be in our heart with love. Jn. 14:16-26; 21. If we do not serve in love we will be as those listed in 2 Tim. 3:1-5. "Having the form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away."

### III. There must be a Whole World Vision

- A. Have a Vision - from God for lost people (Prov. 29:18)
- B. Have a Burden - from God for lost people's needs (Matt. 9:36).
- C. Have some Goals - from God on how you are going to reach the lost.
  - See a need
  - God calls men - surrendered men
  - Equipment to do God's work
  - Start the work with what you have, the quality will grow
  - Get the right Texts
    - Vaticaus - Catholic - Study Rev. chs. 17 & 18 - the whore
    - Alexanderians - Acts 6:7-9, disputors, 13
    - Textus receptus
  - Print it out and give it out

What is the value of a vision? - people won't perish

Who is the victum of the vision? - the church - dead

What is the virtue of a vision - they see you mean business

- if you are stirred up, they will be stirred up
- John 12:24, I must die & Jesus Christ must be first

#### Three things a vision must have

1. A following - "Follow me" Matt. 4:19
2. Financing "You are to take care of God's work (win people) and God will take care of you."
3. Focusing - make the vision clear
  - keep it simple
  - communicate with the people
