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SECTION I: INSPIRATION

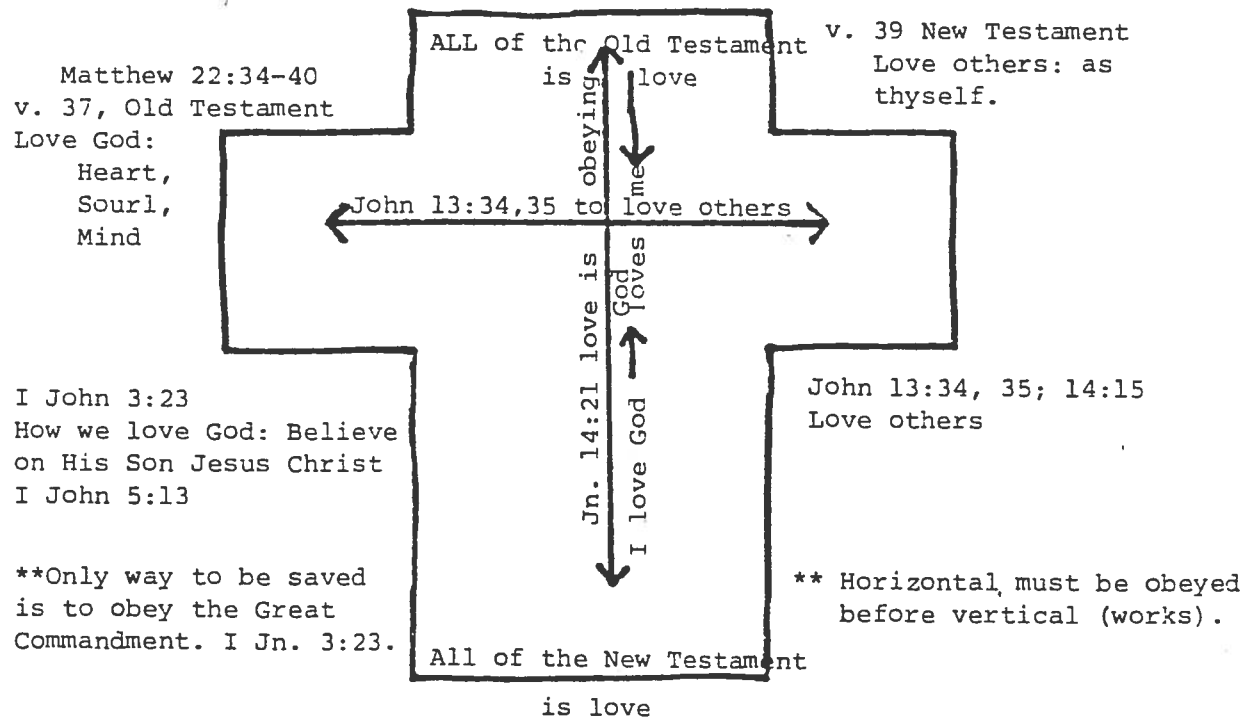
I. The Commandment of Love with Doctrine of Scriptures. I Cor. 13:1-3.

A. Introduction: In Paul's day prophecy is equal to the Word of God.

** Knowledge is "Divine revelation from God" ** I Coringhians 13:10 "that" is neuter, not the pronoun speaking of Christ, but Scriptures. Greatest doctrine is charity. Great Commandment is the "Key to your Life".

1. Greater orator with no love is; sounding brass.
2. All knowledge with no love is; nothing.
3. Generous with no love is; profiting nothing.

If we cutoff others that disagree on the Bible, we cannot teach or help them. Don't make enemies out of friends, share principles with love. God's strength works through our WEAKNESS!!!!



New Testament is personalized "Christ in us. Love others as I have loved you."

*****"He that believeth on me as the Scripture hath said"***** The reason a Christian's life doesn't work is that he violates the Great Commandment.

** The Great Commandment will cause the Great Commission to work.** Paul taught the Great Commandment, that is why he could start a church and leave it in two years or less - every letter brings them back to the "Great Commandment" Romans 13:8-10, Galatians 5:13-15, I Thessalonians 4:9, I Corinthians

13:4-8, 10 Commandments; 1-4 love toward God, 4-10 relationship to our brother. I Thessalonians 3:12, 13 the more Christ is Lord, the more ye love one another. Philippians 1:9 Paul says 1) abound more and more in love, in knowledge, and in all judgment. 2) that ye may approve things that are excellent, 3) that ye may be sincere, 4) without offence till the day of Christ. **Right doctrine without love is OFFENSIVE!!!**

* Make a list of "LOVE YOUR BROTHER IN THE NEW TESTAMENT* King James 1611 Version without love equals NOTHING!! The Great Commission and the Great Commandment comes from the heart. Heart to heart, not head to head. I John 4:20, 21, John 14:21 love is obedience, Holy Spirit doesn't manifest Himself, but Christ. I John 5:1-3 not properly love God if it is grievous to keep the commandments. II John 6. Love is believing on Jesus.**

II. DOCTRINE OF THE SCRIPTURES II Timothy 3:16

Doctrine is the source of everything we have, Hebrews 11, obedience to the Bible is doctrine. II Timothy 3:15-17. Inspired - have breath - expired is death. The Bible will be inspired as long as God is alive. The Breath of God is eternal. Without the breath of God it's not inspired - need the breath to speak a Word.

A. II Timothy 3:16

1. Psalm 33:6-12a, God breathed the world into existence. All things are held together by His power.
2. Genesis 2:7 God breathed in man. We are living epistles.
II Corinthians 3:23.
3. II Timothy 3:16, KJV (King James Version) not inspired in 1611.
Breath comes down thru the ages thru the manuscripts. The one breath is eternal, breath of God is not the original paper, or ink, but the WORD. Inspiration begins WITH the original.

B. II Peter 1:19-21

1. Moses was the human author of 5 books, not his idea, but moved by the Holy Spirit. Jeremiah 36:1-4, 16 (Deuteronomy 17:18-20) 18, 22, 23 was the original and only copy of the Word of God, 27, to destroy the Word you have to destroy God. vs. 28, 38 words added because revelation wasn't complete yet, would have added even if first copy was not destroyed, word is eternal, God is the Active Agent in keeping His Word. Scribe wrote what Jeremiah said.
 - a. Genesis 3:1. First mention of tongues.
 - b. First mention of Bible with omission.

Old Testament inspiration: 35 times "word came in Leviticus - Jeremiah 36 times.

2. Jesus said the Old Testament was Scripture or the Word of God.

Matthew 4:4, Luke 4:4 in the Greek says Word, Deuteronomy 8:3 word is italicized, there is no Hebrew word for word, but it is still inspired according to Jesus when He speaks it in Luke. In 4:18-21, Jesus said Isaiah was Scripture, 16:29-31 Moses and the prophets are the Word of God. Scriptures are better than the supernatural & the raising from the dead. Mark 12:36 is Jesus. Acts 8:30-32 New Testament calls the Old Testament Scripture. Romans 1:1,2 Paul under inspiration calls the Old Testament Scripture.

C. New Testament Inspiration - Doctrine of Scriptures comes from the only Doctrinal Book. I John 2:7,8 Old Commandment, Old Testament, New Testament is the new commandment. Acts 1:1-3 N.T. prophets are Matthew, Mark, Luke, John, Paul, James, Jude, Holy Spirit through the apostles. John 16:12, 13; John 17:17, I Corinthians 14:37, Things I write unto you are commandments of the Lord. I Thessalonians 3:4-6 the Bible is to the church today, as the apostles were to the believers before Revelation 22:21, I Timothy 1:1, Commandment is the Word of God. II Corinthians 1:18-20, II Corinthians 13:10 write these things according to the power to edification. Galatians 1:11-20, vs. 12 came by revelation from Jesus Christ. Vs. 16 not from flesh and blood. Ephesians 3:3-5 wrote by revelation - by the Spirit. Philippians 3:1, II Peter 31,32 3:15-17, Luke 1:1-4 perfect understanding of all things (work of the Holy Spirit).

****The greatest truth we have is what the Bible says about the Bible!****

III. Jesus the Word with the Doctrine of the Scriptures. John 1:1,14

A. Jesus is the Divine Original.

1. Jesus is the Word. If He was a book He would be the Bible.
Jesus said, "These are they that speak of me" testify (bear witness). The Bible is a revelation of Jesus Christ to man.

2. Parallel of Jesus and the Bible.

- a. Jesus conceived by the Holy Spirit author and keeper of the Spirit.....Book.
- b. Jesus virgin born.....Bible by holy men of God
- c. God was His Father.....God is the Author (Father) of Word.
- d. Jesus lived a sinless life.....Pure, holy Word of God.
- e. Jesus confounded the religious and the wise.....The natural man can't understand the Word of God
- f. Jesus full of grace and truth.....John 17:17 Bible is the book of grace, mercy, and truth.
- g. Jesus performed miracles, raised the dead and caused the blind to see....Bible is a miracle book, death to life, blind to see, lame to walk.
- h. Death.....Early church killed-Bible destroyed
- i. Burial.....manuscripts most pure copies.
- j. Resurrection.....Original languages 4-6th Centuries the Received Text.
- k. Ascension.....Psalm 119 Forever the Word is settled in heaven.
- l. Advent of the Holy Ghost.....Translation of the Bible
- m. Holy Ghost same God different form..Same Bible different language.
- n. Jesus of incorruptible seed.....Seed is in the incorruptible Word.
- o. Except seed fall in earth and die Koine Greek is a dead language, it will not bring forth life.....death of the Bible.
- p. Not same kernel brings forth life, but many fruits. John 12:24.....Produces many Bibles
- q. Jesus rejected, mocked, scorned....Bible rejected, mocked, scorned
- r. No corruption after death.....Death of Greek language (Koine) preserves it from further corruption.

B. What does the Word say about the Word, that Baptists say about the King James Version. Baptist will hold up the King James Version AS the Word of God, - so is the original. That the King James Version is the truth, so is the original, and so on as follows: Ephesians 6:17 Sword of the Spirit, II Timothy 2:9 Word is not bound, but is the authority and power, Hebrews 4:12, Quick and powerful as a two edged sword, John 6:63 my words are life and spirit, by it men are born again, James 1:21 engrafted word to save the soul, II Timothy 3:16,17 is profitable for doctrine..., Revelation 2:12 by it we will be judged (the Word of God), John 12:48 My words judge you in the last day, Matthew 22:31 Have ye not read (Word of God), Romans 10:17 source of faith is the Word.

****Claim all the Bible says about itself, EXCEPT inspiration, because scholars say that is in the Greek.****

****It is bad doctrine to raise a question that you will not answer**.**

Jesus is:

1. Living Word John 1:1
2. Spoken Word II Timothy 2:9
3. Written Word is the Living Word II Timothy 1:9-14.

SECTION II: PRESERVATION OF THE BIBLE

I. Lesson I - PROMISE God is preserving His Word.

A. Who is the agent in the preservation of the Word of God?

1. Psalm 12:6,7 Silver is purified 2 times, His word is purified 7 times. Number 7 is the number of perfection.
 - a. Vs. 7 "Thou shalt keep them", Thou is God Himself, He shall preserve His own Word. "Them", refers to the words of God.
 - b. From generation to generation.
2. Actual account of keeping His Word. Jeremiah 36:1-32.
 - a. Vs. 2-4 Jeremiah to write the words that the Lord had given him. Baruch the scribe wrote the words that Jeremiah had spoken unto him.
 - b. Question of preservation. Vs. 17
 - c. Destruction of the original, burned, VS. 22
 - d. God commands Jeremiah to do it again. vs. 27,28
 - e. Doctrine of Scribe preserving Scriptures. vs. 32. Revelation of God not complete, God added to it, NOT MAN!!!

B. Even if we don't believe it, we are FORCED to take the position of preservation, BY THE WORD OF GOD ITSELF!!!

1. Romans 3:2 advantage Jews had over the rest of the world, "Unto them were committed the oracles of God."
 - a. Oracles of God.
 - b. In their own language, for the people (Jews).
 - c. The scribe was the Jew.
2. Vs. 3 "For what if some did not believe, shall their unbelief make the faith of God without effect?" - Could they change God's

faithfulness, What God said He was going to do?

3. Vs. 4, "Let God be true and every man a liar" - then Paul goes back to the written word, "As it is written..."

II. Lesson II - Doctrine of preservation N.T. Scribe - program to preserve His Word.

A. Every believer is a King unto God. Revelation 1:6, "made us kings & Priests."

1. Deuteronomy 17:18, King to make his own copy.

- a. It shall be with him. vs. 19, sword.
- b. Read there in all the days of thy life. See Matthew 6:33.
- c. To learn the fear of the Lord.
- d. To keep all the words . . . and to do them, James 1:22, Matthew 7:24-26, one was a doer, one wasn't.

2. Vs. 20, Reasons for writing out the Word of God, personally.

- a. That his heart be not lifted up above his brethren. Pride. Pride is the number one Baptist sin.
- b. That he turn not aside from the Commandment - Jesus.
- c. To prolong his days - he and his children.

B. Every believer is a priest unto God. Revelation 1:6

1. Priesthood of the believer, Hebrews 4:16. To the throne.

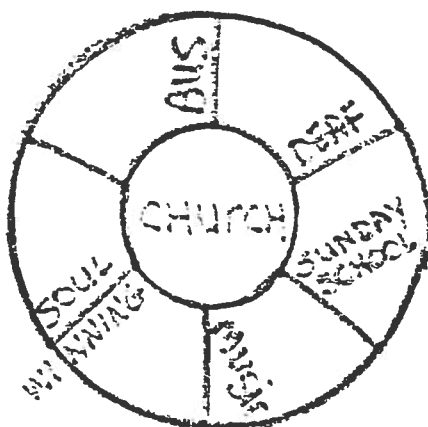
- a. New Testament priest

- 1) Has needs met by mercy, if you come to Him in prayer.
- 2) And grace, grace is power of God working out the details in your life that you can't possibly do.

- b. Old Testament priest

- 1) Had access to the throne of grace.
- 2) Was commanded to read 'source of faith', and pray "source of power".

2. Priesthood of the believer, to the Holy things. Numbers 4:4.
 - a. Holy things is plural, includes the Word of God.
 - b. Numbers 3:31 in charge of the ark.
 - 1) Manna - type of Christ.
 - 2) Aaron's rod - type of the resurrection.
 - 3) Tables of stone, first written Word of God.
 - c. Moses wrote the Pentateuch, which was the law and history of the Israelites (or Jews). This was to be placed in the ark also and put into the care of the priests. Deuteronomy 31:24-26.
3. They had more than just the responsibility of printing the Word.
 - a. Scripture publishing (N.T. Scribe) is the spoke we have left out of God's program.



- b. God set up a program early to protect and preserve His Word.
- C. Must be a priest to copy the Word of God. Numbers 18:7.

** The five most important words in the office of preservation are:
"Shall keep your priest's office."

 1. O.T. priest paid by tithes for his service to God.
 2. Service is a gift.
 - a. Copied the Word without charge (DON'T CHARGE FOR A BIBLE!!)
 - b. Didn't charge for prayer
 3. Believer priest in the N.T. doesn't charge for his services.
 4. The things of God are to be freely given and freely received.
Psalm 68:11, "The Lord gave the word..." See Revelation 22:17.
 5. Deuteronomy 18:7, The stranger that cometh nigh (office of priest) shall be put to death.

- a. No stranger allowed near office of the priest.
 - b. Scriptures copied, protected, and preserved by the believer priest. *Material bought by the children of God.
 - c. Scriptures copied for free distribution.
6. Ezekiel 44:6-8 Contains contents of abomination to God.
- a. Vs. 7, Strangers not allowed in the sanctuary.
 - b. Uncircumcised in heart - saved.
 - c. Uncircumcised in flesh - separation.
 - d. Strangers will pollute the sanctuary, "even my house".
 - e. Bread, fat, and blood, worship, were polluted.
 - f. Your abominations (caused My covenant to be broken). We let the world print OUR BOOK!!

****If you handle the Word of God make sure it's pure without corruption.****
 God has a standard. Don't add or take away. Revelation 22:18,19. Doesn't say if you don't understand, just don't add or take away.

- 7. Matthew 23:23 "Have omitted the weightier matters...these ye ought to have done". See Vs. 28, Numbers 3:31. We have set keepers over our charge and now we are paying. vs. 38.
- 8. Matthew 23:34, Jesus to religious people of His day. We didn't kill the prophets of our fathers (promise of N.T. prophets Matthew, Mark, Luke, John, and Paul, etc.) wise men = pastors, and scribes = the N.T. scribe (published Scriptures for 500 years).
****We did not keep our priest office - scribe.****

D. Synopsis of the New Testament Scribe.

- 1. Only the Priest has the authority to print God's Word.
- 2. We are made a Priest by work of Christ upon being saved.
- 3. God's ordained program.

a. The Church

b. God's priest is to work through God's program.

**If God said to do it a particular way, do it! God is all-knowing.

4. Scriptures are to be a free gift.

5. No strangers allowed. Unsaved and unseparated not to print.

6. We know from the Bible, Ezekiel 44:7 that they will pollute it.

7. Only the New Testament Church is ordained to print the Word of the living God without polluting it. Gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

E. Sound Doctrine is to be printed, protected, and preserved by:

1. Believer priest

2. Holy men of God.

3. Saved, baptized church members.

4. He is in Christ, and Christ is in him.

5. Indwelt by the Holy Ghost.

6. Kept by the power of God.

**Can't defend the faith without defending the Bible.

Can't defend the Bible without defending the King James Version' 1611.

Can't defend the Bible without controlling who prints it.**

II. Lesson III - New Testament Church active in Scripture copying, distributing the Word of God.

Philippians 2:16 Those who rejoice are obedient, if we don't run and work our labour is in vain.

- A. Romans 16:28, Written to the Romans, a scribal note, from Corinth, sent by Phebe, a servant of the church.
- B. I Corinthians 16:25, written from Philippi, lists 4 scribes that copied or reproduced what Paul wrote.
- C. II Corinthians 13:14 written from Philippi, copied by Titus and Luke.
- D. Galatians 6:19, Written from Rome, there was 4 churches in Galatia, 4 copies were sent to the churches, they passed on the original letter but each had a copy.
- E. Colossians 4:16, "Cause this epistle to be read also in the church of Laodiceans." Was to be copied and sent to Laodicea. Laodicea was to do the same thing.
3 positions on what happened to the other letter:
 - 1. Laodicea didn't copy it and it died.
 - 2. Was not an inspired letter.
 - 3. Laodicea may have had another epistle (letter), as the Colossian's letter that was sent to them.
- F. Book of Revelation to 7 churches. Revelation 1:4, 7 copies of Revelation were copied and distributed. The Gentile churches were active in copying and sending.
- G. Churches had scribes for 500 years, Colossians 4:16 shows it was a common activity, a N.T. practice and a command of God.

IV. Lesson 4 - The New Testament church active in distributing the Word of God.

. **Our part in preservation is simple, just multiply the copies and send them to many different areas.**

- A. Acts 8:28 The Ethiopian was reading a copy of Isaiah. This shows and teaches distribution to the lost, as the Ethiopian wasn't a student of the Word as he didn't understand what it said.
- B. Acts 17:11, Jews in the synagogue searched the Scriptures daily.
- C. Romans 16:25,26 To preach Jesus Christ to all nations in their language.
- D. I Peter 1:25 "And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you. See II Corinthians 4:3-5.
- E. Colossians 4:16, Church active in printing. The very letter to each church shows distribution to the churches by the churches.
- F. II Timothy 1:5,6; 3:15 Distribution to the home, to believers, and to the foreign field.
- G. Why was there distribution to the churches, home, believers, and to the foreign field?
 - 1. That your joy may be full. I John 1:4
 - 2. That ye sin not. I John 2:1
 - 3. Because your sins are forgiven for His name's sake. I John 2:12.
 - 4. So that the Word of God can abide in you. I John 2:14
 - 5. Desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby
I Peter 2:2
 - 6. To become skillful in the word of righteousness, to teach.
Hebrews 5:12,13.

7. To be able to discern both good and evil. Hebrews 5:14
8. People that know the truth need it. That no lie (is of the truth) be given out. I John 2:21.
9. So not to be seduced by false teachers. I John 2:26.
10. It is quick and powerful and sharper than any two edged sword...is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. It is to be used to get the sin out of our life or it will cripple us and our ministry. **It assures your heart of salvation and eternal life.** Hebrews 4:12.
11. This is the written record that "God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in His son." I John 5:13
12. That ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God. I John 5:13.
13. "These are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God' and that believing ye might have life through his name." John 20:31.

V. Lesson 5 - Preservation and restoration of Scriptures and our human responsibility.

A. Comparing Scripture with Scripture, to find responsibility.

1. Responsibility in the Old Testament. II Kings 22:8 shows that the priests neglected their duties. Found the Bible (book of the law). Vs. 10,11 There was weeping, renting of clothes because the Word was not copied. God spared the kingdom from judgment when they began to read and obey.
2. Romans 3:1-3 shows human responsibility in the New Testament.
3. Psalm 68:11 shows preservation and human responsibility.

****We are responsible to every language because we have the Great Command - Commission.****

B. How to find a good copy of the Word.

1. To print the Bible in a foreign language, there must be no omissions or additions. Revelation 22:18,19.
2. Englishmen can't correct a French language Bible, or Spanish, German, Romanian, etc...
3. Must find an Old Translation from the Received Text.
 - a. Have copies made - microfilm copy made.
 - b. Someone must know the language.
 - c. Check copy against copy for error or against the KJV and the Received Text.
 - d. Recheck work with another group.
 - 1) II Corinthians 11:4, Another Jesus, or another gospel.
 - 2) I Timothy 3:15, The church is the pillar and ground of the truth.

- 3) Matthew 18:16, II Corinthians 13:1 by the mouth of two or three witnesses. John 8:17, Deuteronomy 19:15.
- e. God will raise up people and copies to work with you and you can expect Him to. Where there is no Bible the Holy Spirit cannot work.
4. Divine preservation will reproduce. Everything has the seed to reproduce, the Law of reproduction, "after it's kind" also the Law of sowing and reaping.
- a. Psalm 126:6, There is seed in the Bible, the Bible itself is it's own seed.
- b. Luke 8:11, "The seed is the Word of God." Bad seed, won't reproduce or will give bad, bad fruit. Good seed (the new birth, soulwinning, spirit growth, zealous Christians.)
- c. Matthew 13:38, "Good seed are the children of the kingdom, but the tares are the children of the wicked one."
- d. Matthew 13:24-30, an application: There are two seeds, one will produce good fruit, children of the kingdom. The bad seed will not produce good fruit, Jesus said would produce children of the wicked one, and they would be gathered and burned in the fire; so shall it be at the end of this world. Matthew 13:40. God doesn't remove the bad see, until the end. We will do more hurt to the pure Word of God by fighting over the bad seed. **Just reproduce good seed in the language with which you are working, don't focus on the bad seed, PRINT GOOD SEED.

IV. LESSON 6 - Preservation of the Bible in light of persecution.

- A. John a brother and companion in tribulation for the Word and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.
 - 1. Persecution always follows obedience to printing God's Word in obedience to His command.
 - 2. A church has to be strong spiritually in order to take on the Bible printing ministry.
- B. Matthew 23:20-24, Prophets gave the Word of God and were killed from the beginning. Jesus said He would send more and they would be killed also. Persecution has always and will always be for the Word of God.
- C. Publishing Scriptures is God's principle program of preservation.
 - 1. Revelation 6:9, Slain for the Word of God.
 - 2. Revelation 20:4,6 Beheaded for the Word of God, the tribulation saints. *Jesus was the first person, the first part of the first resurrection.*
 - 3. Tyndale translated first English Bible in 1526 from the (Received Text?) and was hung by King of England.
 - 4. Luther suffered persecution over the Word of God.

II. Lesson 7 - Our part in preservation of the Word of God.

- A. Romans 3:1-4, Profit Jew, by Jew, for Jew. We have some advantage, we have the oracles of God committed to us.
- B. I Corinthians 4:1, Stewards of the mysteries of God. It is REQUIRED in stewards, that a man be found faithful. The mysteries are found in the Word of God.
- C. We are not as many; which corrupt the Word of God...We don't and we are not many. Corrupt meaning:
 - 1. Watered down and then selling it.
 - 2. Selling Word corrupts it. Bible of the month club.
- D. II Corinthians 4:1-3, Therefore seeing we have this ministry.
 - 1. This ministry (to be a witness unto me) written to mission church on the 2nd missionary journey, being a witness to the world.
 - 2. We have received mercy.
 - 3. Dishonest - don't print, no craftiness allowed, deceitfully handled the word in Paul's day, but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.
 - 4. Personal responsibility to vs. 3, get it out to the lost.
- E. Colossians 4:16
- F. I Thessalonians 2:4
 - 1. Changing the Bible will change the gospel, death, burial, and resurrection, according to the Scriptures.
 - 2. Not pleasing men.
 - 3. Pleasing God.
 - 4. Trieth our hearts. We need mercy.

III. Lesson 8 - Two lines of preservation.

****Where did God preserve His New Testament Words?*** II Corinthians 11: 13-15 warns of false prophets transforming themselves into apostles of Christ, they will receive their reward but also take many with them. Matthew 13:37-43, by using bad seed instead of good seed.

A. Two lines of Bible preservation to choose from.

1. First line - Believer's position, traditional text support, over 5,000+ existing Greek Texts. Greet Textus Receptus basis for our King James Version, we are forced to accept the Bible position to fulfil God's program.
2. Second line - Scholarship, says not preserved accurately. Wescott and Hort, Bible corrupt and they set out to correct it. Vaticanicus and Siniaticus - Roman Catholic church held the greatest truth.

B. Position of Bible preservation to choose from.

1. Believer - by faith God supernaturally preserved His Word from generation to generation, Psalm 12:7. God's promise of preservation is of the same quality as inspiration of His Word.
2. Scholarship - God did certainly inspire but preservation comes through natural means, using men to restore as close to the original as humanly possible. Scholarship is unbelief - intellectualism rules for selecting texts, not using Bible principles but they use evolutionary means.

C. Two organizations of Bible preservation.

1. Believers - Local N.T. Church, Christ founded with a severe warning about altering it.

2. Scholarship - All churches failed except Roman Catholic - World Bible Society.
- D. Two agents of Bible preservation to choose from.
1. Committed to all Believer Priests through church uniformity between thousands of texts.
 2. Scholarship - only Greek and Hebrew men can tell the difference between good and bad texts.
- E. Two sources of Bible printing and distribution.
1. Command to all churches. Romans 16:26
 2. Bible publishing house. Bible of your choice.
- F. Two different meanings to Bible preservation.
1. God breathed over 1600 period of years of writing His Word,-- throughout church age preservation. II Timothy 3:15,16.
 2. Only refers to original autographs, not with a copy of that copy. Limits inspiration of God through the writer only. **Word is the breath, not the men inspired.**
- G. Two views of Bible translation in view of preservation.
1. Believers - translation, Acts 2:5-8, example, they heard in their own language, work of the Holy Spirit, Romans 16:25,26 by commandment.
 2. Scholarship - translation, can't be called inspiration text even Hebrew and Greek texts not inspired.
- H. Two views of Bible unbelief of Bible preservation.
1. Any rejection of King James Version is unbelief in God and His power.
 2. Bible unbelief is with the originals, the believers are the ones who changed the words.

I. Two basic views of King James Version 1611 translation.

1. Church acceptance for 370 years of blessing proves only current Bible teaching, Divine preservation.
2. It is dangerous to base on it being perfect or the best Greek text, teaches heresy in certain places.

J. Two views of, work of the Holy Spirit.

We don't understand God or how the Holy Spirit does His work.

1. Agreement of over 5000+ manuscripts.

ORIGINALS

TEXTUS RECEPTUS

Certain % in the pattern, between 90 - 95%.

The Textus Receptus has some variation in the pattern - is an absolute plus, it is corroborative testimony (Bible practice 2 or 3 witnesses). If Matthew to John were exactly the same, would it be 4 gospels? No. They don't say the same thing exactly, but a variant in witness establishes the testimony. One event seen by different men makes for 4 stories different in content, but all basically alike.

2. Holy Spirit didn't preserve. 331 times in Nestles text there are different readings, presents a problem in text. 269 not in New American Standard Version - 85% of the time they use of the of the corrupt texts instead of using the agreeing texts.

K. Two views on questionable verses in the King James Version.

1. We admit our own ignorance - but no errors. We are just children and are still learning. **By faith we understand.**
2. King James Version on Testus Receptus teaching heresy.

L. Two views of satan's work in Bible preservation.

**Is the devil trying to pollute and corrupt the Bible? Yes! What is he doing?*

1. Satan is a textual critic - omits from the Bible.
 2. God preserved all manuscripts - omits satan's influence.
- M. Two approaches of Bible preservation.
1. We believe in authority of Scriptures, by God and are authentic.
 2. Textual criticism is a natural way to explain away things that they don't like, (the blood) and to examine God by men's standards.

****The issue of the Bible is always settled in the pew by the Believer priest.****

SECTION III-CORRUPTION OF THE BIBLE

I. Lesson I - Don't add to it or take away from it.

A. Revelation 22:18,19 cross reference Deuteronomy 4:2; 12:32 Don't add to or take away from.

Proverbs 30:5,6 Add not unto His words or be found a liar.

Revelation 22:18,19 Applies to the whole Bible not just one book.
**Scholarship says "There are no major Doctrines affected in the changes."
God didn't say not to add or take away from Doctrine, but His Words.**
The Bible is a legal document - if altered, legal documents are broken, the contract is not God. God said if the contract is broken you will be taken out of the Book of Life, from the Holy City, and add unto him the plagues that are written in this book. **God didn't say UNLESS done in ignorance.**

B. What corrupts a Bible?

We don't condemn other versions, God's Word condemns all new translations. Bible standard, has to be unwavering, without error, steadfast, unchanging.

II. Lesson II - Another Bible.

II Corinthians 11:3 "But I fear" - responds to the last part of verse 4, "Ye might well bear with him". This was not written to a carnal church.

II Corinthians 11:4, "Bear with" means to easily go along with them.

II Corinthians 11:13-15, Ministers of righteousness, is scholarship.

II Corinthians 11:3,4 "But I fear" is a warning about satan and his attack. "Lest by and means" - to attack the Word of God. Satan took advantage of Eve's ignorance and simplicity and will try to do the same to us.

Genesis 3:1 is the first mention of tongues, satan empowered the serpent to speak. It is also the first omission, tongues is an attack on the complete revelation of the Bible, saying that the Bible is not trustworthy. Satan comes in and attacks Christians through tongues.

Eve lost simple faith in the reliability of God's Word when satan questioned it.

The first mention of omission is satanic and so is anyone else or any translation that omits a verse or a word.

There are 8674 word differences.

NOTE: 807 changes in the American Standard 1901. (New American Standard Version.)

New International Version 509 changes.

When you change the Bible you change Jesus - Jesus is the Word.

I Timothy 3:16, John 1:1-3, 14.

III. Lesson III - Another Spirit.

I John 4:1-3 Check the Spirit, what it says of Christ. The Holy Spirit is the author and protector. Change the Book and you change the Spirit.

Galatians 1:6 - Another gospel - to change or omit, or add changes to the Bible, will cause you to pervert the gospel of Christ. See II Corinthians 11:4, Gospel, God in the flesh, died and rose again, Take out the deity and the blood, change the Bible and you change the gospel.

Scholarship and new translations, American Bible Society, Wycliff Bible Society, Gideon - commercial publishing.

**If someone receives the false first, they usually won't receive God's Word when presented.

IV. Lesson IV - Corruption of the Scriptures

II Peter 2:1 Swift destruction - **Always have a combination of good and bad. Just do right and swamp them with good Bibles.

II Peter 2:2 May shall follow their ways. The way of truth shall be evil spoken of. And the way of truth already has passed through history which scholarship says was corrupted by men.

II Peter 2:3 Feigned words make merchandise of you. Why 132 translations, where there is a lot of money and none in the poor countries??? God will judge them.

II Peter 3:15-17 Bibles prove God taught us to write it down - not to lose the truth.

Vs. 16

- A. Somethings are suppose to be hard to understand - to make it easy is wrong, and usually is the wrong interpretation.
- B. Unlearned and unstable - twist, they don't know the ways of God.
- C. As they do also to other scriptures to their own destruction , changing it. ****TO THEIR OWN DESTRUCTION.****

Vs. 17

- A. Beware by 3rd chapter of Genesis "yea hath God said" - satanic attack.
- B. Lest ye being led away with error of the wicked.
- C. Fall from your own steadfastness - if we have a Bible (corrupted II Corinthians 2:17 and and handled deceitfully II Corinthians 4:2) Catholic etc. thinks is great - Protestants fought over that very issue at the Reformation, liberals go along with their Catholic theology.

SECTION IV DOCTRINE OF SCRIPTURES TRANSLATION

Isaiah 55:6-11.

A. God putting His thoughts and words into human language is a type of translation. Anthrophomorphism - God uses a human object to illustrate expressions that we might understand, "God's hand is not shortened that he cannot save."

B. Translation within the confines of the Bible, Old Testament in Hebrew and Aramic and New Testament in Greek. 100s of times Hebrew is translated in the New Testament it is the Word of God and God did it.

....assignment....

C. Jesus while on earth in Aramaic (spoke) - when quoted in Greek, "Have ye not read" (what is in the Word of God) a copy.

D. Acts 2:5,6 Every nation represented - 11 from Asia - languages. Scriptures translated into many languages.

**Distribution of Scripture, Moses gave them a book (tables of stone) translations into languages of the world, before foundation.

F. Romans 16:25-27 cross reference Ephesians 3:3,9; Colossians 1:25. Mystery - salvation of Gentiles manifest and by the Scriptures - (Make gospel to Gentiles known - foretold). **The problem is not the darkness, but us - laziness - disobedience in not getting Scriptures in the hands of the people.

Vs. 26 - But now is made manifest and by the Scriptures of the prophets (New and Old Testament) according to the commandment of the everlasting ... faith.

Everything is accredited today thru the Word of God. We must have the word to make the program function. Saved - Baptised, but that's it because of either a corrupt or no Bible.

I Peter 1:23,25 Born again, not of corruptible - liveth forever.

**Where there is no Word, Scirpture , the Holy Spirit does not work.

John 10 convicts of sin, righteousness and judgment. Proverbs 28:18.

No vision (Word of God) Scripture. II Timothy 3:16 Inspiration. Breathed original thru your Bible, your life, the living Epistle known and seen of all men.

II Thessalonians 3:1, Word of the Lord may have free course and glorified even as it is with you. (All the people have the same Word as we have.).

A. When Scripture speaks, Matthew 22:31, God speaks.

B. Paul under inspiration said, no difference between Scripture and God speaking.

C. Holy Spirit calls copies of the original and translations Scripture.

"Corrupted Bibles gives God bad breath"(Inspiration). B Hillar.

A corrupt translation is not word changes from one language to another but omissions of words, sentences, paragraphs, or changes of meaning of the words.

New discovery of old manuscripts, God says "Nothing new under the sun."

We already had the same truth in the other manuscripts. Scholarship says

"We claim a more accurate manuscript because of antiquity." But that is

not Biblical, "Preserved from generation to generation" so the latest

would not be best.

There are very few facts in textual criticism, but many opinions. We need to turn to what the Bible says "Let God be True and every man a liar." Stay with the Bible.

THE KING JAMES VERSION BIBLICAL HISTORICAL FACTS

- A. King James Version 1611, the only translation used in English today that follows the Bible principles.
- B. KJV 1611, translators didn't depend on their own scholarship, they revised the translations available. They went back and checked on scholarship before hand (Past ages).
- C. Began with 54 men by request of the King, 47 finished, were giants in their field. Used Biblical scholarship.
- D. Didn't use language of 1611, but pure Anglo-Saxon about 70 years old, not a language of the street, because it changes too fast, but used the same as it is used in Law today, because they held that word. Anglo-Saxon form - same group of godly men, and a pure language will never be repeated.
- E. Can't update KJV 1611 (Not spelling of words, changes labour to labor). New King James Translation is like new patches on old skin (bottles)
- F. KJV 1611, has proved itself for 370 years, saved souls, churches established, missionaries sent.
- G. It is God honored, time tested, soul saving, and honors God.
- H. God used it. Made English the trade language of the world.
- I. It is the Bible militant Baptists use.
- J. Without being introduced to textual criticism, hold standard God is pleased with because God has used it.
